PORTLAND MARKET REPORT.

Portland, Or., Jan. 13.—Some trade is reported in the local hog market around former figures. Inquiries are increasing, but easterners are going slow with their purchases—in fact feeling their way.

The walterville Times says of the New York situation:
"The local market is recovering from its holiday recess and we hear of a little business being done here during the past week. One of the largest sales reported is that of the Lewis and McGinnis lot of between 90 and 100 hogs, terms private.

There were also other similar lots picked up here the latter part of last week at current prices, but there was not enough doing to make any great stir on what has become an exceedingly quiet market.

Monday's Bulletin gives the following estimates of the 1909 crop:
"The 1909 United States crop is figured by a trade authority at 210,000 bales, of which 47,000 bales are still unsold in growers' hands as follows: Oregon, 24,000; California, 15,000; Washington, 25,000; New York, 5,500. In addition to the above it is estimated that there remain unsold in first hands in the United States 2000 1908s, 6500 1907s and 6800 1906s, or a total of 62,300 bales of hogs. These figures compare with 35,000 1908s, 20,000 1907s and 13,000 1906s, or a total of 71,000 bales unsold in growers' hands in the United States a year ago."

The Kentish (England) Observer of December 23 says:
"Trade in hogs now presents quite an aspect of holiday, the demand having become normal for the period of the year. Prices, however, are very firm, and stocks unsold are smaller than they have been for many years. Continental prices are also very firm, and stocks very short. American markets are inactive, with lower prices for inferior quality, but anything like fine sorts fully maintain recent quotations."

The heaviest operations locally that have come to light were those of John Carmichael, the representative of Wigan, Richardson & Co., of London. Among Carmichael's purchases that have been reported were 225 bales from William Brown, of Salem, 291 bales from Daniels & Bishop, of McMinnville, and 148 bales from D. Jacobson, of Buena Vista, all taken at 21 cents. Other dealers who have been buying for export in the past few days are Klauer, Wolf & Netter, Isaac Pineus & Sons and Henry L. Bents.

Nearly every dealer with Eastern connections is also in the market for hogs. Krebs Bros. have made purchases and are after more, and other dealers are also operating on Eastern orders. H. V. Bolam has made a large purchase of 1908s at about 17 1/2 cents.

California wires yesterday reported that market strong, with Sonoma growers holding, for 24 cents.

Large-Size Prunes in Demand.
Regarding stock of prunes available on the Coast and the condition of the Eastern markets, the latest issue of the New York Commercial says:

"Coast holdings are closely cleaned up in both 30s and 40s. Sales on the latter sizes are reported for shipment on a 3 1/2¢ four-size bag basis f. o. b. Coast. Oregon prunes are strong on 30s, but 40s and sizes down to 70s inclusive seemed to be offered freely here and on the Coast. It is estimated that stock of Oregon prunes on the Coast do not exceed 40 carloads all told. There is a good local interest in all the stock and the outlook seems to be more promising on all sizes in 40s to 60s. Stocks of California prunes on the Coast are said to be under 18,000,000 pounds in first hands."

Poultry Market Holds Well.
For the week thus far poultry receipts have been light, but the demand has been sufficient to take the bulk of the stock sent in at the prices ruling at the close of last week. The demand is principally for chickens and ducks, but other lines are moving in a fair way. Heavier offerings and a better trade all around are expected from tomorrow to the end of the week.

Veal that will grade as fancy moves readily at 11 to 12 cents a pound, but coarse and heavy stuff is not so easily disposed of, even at prices several cents under top quotations. Best-grade dressed pork goes freely at 10 to 11 cents and current receipts are rather under requirements.

Egg Market on Down Grade.
That the seasonal decline in the egg market is on its indicated by developments on the street today. Dealers reported fresh Oregon eggs coming at a rate to force prices down, 37 1/2¢ to 40 cents being the range quoted, and it is said that some of the commission houses during the day offered Oregon eggs at 35 cents.

Quantities of fresh California eggs received with the past few days have been a factor in the market. It is said that these can be laid down

here for about 36 cents. Eastern eggs naturally drag.

PORTLAND LIVESTOCK MARKET.

Portland Union Stockyards, Stockdale, Jan. 13.—Yesterday's record in local hog market, was overtopped today by 10c, a new high market being reached here at \$9.20. Again does the Portland market reach above every other market in the country so far as swine are concerned; a fact that is pleasing to the entire livestock commission trade of Portland as well as to farmers who are naturally interested in a most vital manner.

Good Run Easily Absorbed.
While there was quite a fair run of hogs in the yards yesterday, still the number of swine that came forward was not half of what the demand called for. Following the small supply over Sunday, today's showing was not so good as might be expected with such high values in effect.

There was a good showing of cattle in the yards today and trade was good with prices showing practically no change. Steers can be good enough to bring \$5.25, while cows of top quality could be sold at \$4.25. In fact both of these prices were reached the other day for some stock that came from the south.

Market for calves is firmer and prices are from 10 to 15c above the previous range.

Run of sheep was small during the day and the market held very firm around former prices.
