## EASTERN GOLFERS MEET AT BOSTON

Boston, Jan. 17.—Presidents of the golf associations of Massachusetts, New York, Pennsylvania, Connecticut and Rhode Island met here today to consider the possibilities of averting a war with the western golfers, who are on the war path, asserting that they have not been given a square deal by the eastern bodies.

In a statement on the subject the delegates to the present conference branded the action of the westerners as "unsportsmanlike."

"No instance is on record in which the views of the whole country have not been carefully considered by the United States Golf Association," says the statement.

"Chicago has received equitable representation on the executive board; has received her full share of the championship meetings; has had a voice in the amendments to the rules, which were adopted to the St. Andrews committee, and the method of nominating officers has been changed to suit her views."

## ENTRIES FOR SOUTHERN ATHLETIC MEET

New Orleans, Jan. 17.—Entries for the third annual indoor championship meet of the Southern branch of the Amateur Athletic Union of the United States were made up today, and show a long list of the best sprinters, runners and gladiators of Dixie. The meet will be held next Saturday.

The following is the list of events: twenty-five yard dash for novices; twenty-five yard dash for seniors; 440-yard dash; 880-yard run; one-mile run; three mile run; pole vault; running high jump; standing broad jump; hop step and jump; twelve-pound shot; 880-yard relay race for prep. schools only one-mile relay race for clubs.

Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to the first three men in each event, and a cup to the college or club team winning the most points, the relay race not counted. The Beavers' trophy will be given to the team winning the race.

## HARRISBURG BEATS JUNCTION CITY
