HILL AND HARRIMAN REACH AGREEMENT

Trouble Over Deschutes Right-of-Way Has Been Amicably Settled

Portland, Jan. 23.—After contesting 5 months in the Deschutes valley and impeding the construction progress by each other as much as possible, the Deschutes Railway Company and the Oregon Trunk Line have at last adjusted all differences to the satisfaction of each.

This adjustment has been accomplished, not, as some feared it would be, by the withdrawal of one railroad from the field, but in some shape that both roads will now be able to rush construction to the interior of the state. Two roads will be built, and the prospects are now bright that both will be in operation Central Oregon in the coming summer.

Under the terms of the agreement the crossing of the O. R. & N. tracks will remain amicably, locations in the lower and upper canyon have been agreed upon, the conflict at Crooked river crossing adjusted and all right-of-way conflicts south of Madras swept away.

HERMANN SECRETS SEALED BY COURT

Portland, Or., Jan. 23.—Refusal of Judge Wolverton to allow Prosecutor Henry to show that letterpress copybooks destroyed by the contained evidence necessary to connect Herman with the Blue Mountain conspiracy, marked the end of the second week of the trial. The Government attempted to prove that the books referred to were removed from the office and destroyed when Herman resigned.

Irvin Rittenhouse was on the witness stand and had testified that it was the practice in the General Land Office, in the incumbency of the defendant, to divide the mail before it was opened. All letters from Oregon, which were marked personal, were sent to the Commissioner for his personal attention. Hermann would examine the communications, forward many of them to various departments for replies, and retain others for his personal attention. Replies to personal letters would be dictated to Rittenhouse, acting as private stenographer, and would be copied in the books which have disappeared. In ruling against the evidence brought by the prosecution, Judge Wolverton said:

"In showing that the records were destroyed the inference is sought to be left with the jury, that Mr. Hermann was destroying copies of letters connecting him with the Blue Mountain Forest Reserve conspiracy. This is going too far outside the record."

Will Address Men's Meeting at University Under Auspices of the Y. M. C. A.

Every one of the 25 delegates from the city association and the Y. M. C. A. at the University who heard Fred B. Smith at Corvallis are enthusiastic over the prospect of his visit to Eugene this evening. When one has heard him it is easy to agree with the statement that he is the greatest speaker to men in the United States. His logic is sound, his eloquence is tremendously forcible and his personality is of the gripping kind that holds the attention of his audience from the time he first addresses his crowd till he sits down.

At Corvallis he spoke to 1500 men in the armory on Sunday afternoon and almost as many people in the evening. He is scheduled to speak to men only in Willard Hall this evening at 7:30 o'clock. His subject is "The Strong Man," and he is a splendid type of "The Strong Man," physically and mentally, himself. At 6:15, the business men of the city will meet with Mr. Smith at Otto's grill.
