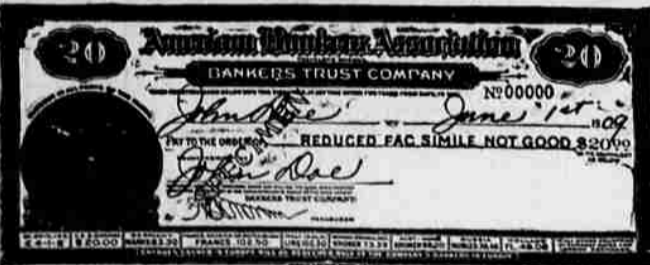

CONTRACT LET FOR EXTENSION FROM VALE, OR.

Another Link in Harriman System Will Be Rushed Through

Ontario, Or., March 20.—The Utah Construction Company was awarded the contract for the construction of the Harriman extension from Vale to Klamath Falls, Or., which is approximately 300 miles. This company also has the contract for building the Harriman line from Klamath Falls to Natron, Or., which is approximately 175 miles. One thousand men are at work from Natron down, and from Klamath Falls up. The line from Natron is finished to Eugene, a distance of 15 miles, and much of the roadbed work between Natron and Klamath Falls is finished.

The Southern Pacific will run its main line from Portland to San Francisco by way of Eugene and Klamath Falls, to avoid the difficult grades over the Siskiyou mountains. The Vale extension to Klamath Falls gives the Harriman road a new main line from Ontario to Portland and San Francisco. The general manager of the Utah Construction Company was at Eugene and showed to Colonel E. Hofer a telegram he received awarding the Utah Company the contract for building the line from Vale to Klamath Falls.

It is now known that the Oregon Short Line cut-off, putting Boise on the main line from Owyhee to New Plymouth and thence to Ontario, where it connects with the line to Vale, putting Boise on the main line to Portland and San Francisco by way of Klamath Falls. J. R. Blackaby, the Ontario banker, has a letter from Colonel Hofer announcing the awarding of the contract to the Utah Construction Company.

ENGLISH PREMIER HAS FAMILY ROW

Mr. Asquith and Wife Are Reported As About to Separate

London, March 20.—Although it has been denied from America, it is rumored and re-rumored that Maud Allen the famous barefoot dancer, who had a great vogue in British society last fall, has had more or less to do with the Asquiths and their family troubles.

Miss Allen, according to a cable dispatch, says she was not an intimate friend of the family, and met Mr. Asquith and his wife only casually at receptions and luncheons and dinners where all were bidden. From one of Mrs. Asquith's own set, however, it is learned that Miss Allen has been giving the wife of the premier lessons in the art to which she has devoted herself. It is said, too, that the example set by Lady Constance Richardson in leaving her position in society and going upon the stage made a profound impression upon Mrs. Asquith. To Mr. Asquith, whose position especially demands a congenial wife, her dancing lessons are said to have been abhorrent.

Mrs. Asquith has always been ambitious, and if there is a title to be gained by waiting, the separation may be indefinitely postponed.

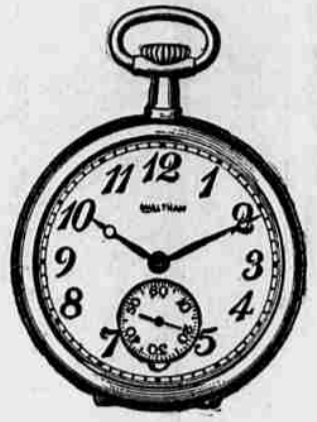
