MAN WHO SHOT MRS. RENSHAW'S HORSE ARRESTED

One Anderson Arrested This Afternoon—Mrs. Renshaw Identifies Him

A man believed to be the one who shot and killed Mrs. W. M. Renshaw's horse on the Coburg road north of Eugene on May 23, 1909, is in the county jail, having been arrested late this afternoon by Deputy Sheriff R. M. Pratt and George Fisk at the Schofield Chemical works, where he was employed. The man who gives his name as Anderson, was identified by Mrs. Renshaw after his arrest as the one who attempted to hold her up and who shot her horse and fired several shots at her when the wounded animal dashed past him. He is about 26 or 28 years of age and has been working for Schofield for some time past. It is learned that he has been living in a tent across the river for a year. It was through information furnished Sheriff Bowen by C. E. Fero that Anderson was placed under arrest. It is said that while the latter was intoxicated a short time ago, he became quite talkative and spoke of the shooting of Mrs. Renshaw's horse in such a way that he was suspected of the crime. With Mrs. Renshaw's identification of the man, the officers are quite certain that they have the right one. Anderson is charged with assault with intent to kill and will be arraigned before Judge Bryson, of the justice court this evening at 7 o'clock.

Paramour of Confessed Murderer Tells Story of His Crimes

San Francisco, April 21.—Jealousy over the discovery that Charles Chiften, the confessed murderer, had intimate relations with half a dozen others, has led Annie Bell, daughter of a Spanish rancher near Hollister, California, to tell the police of San Jose that Chiften, who confessed to the murder of Policeman George Whitbark at Santa Clara, also slew three other men. Deputy Sheriff A. W. Linquist, of Berkeley; Fred A. Smith, a motorman of San Francisco, and William Schneider, who was killed in a bath house here, besides being the notorious drug store bandit, and having committed numerous robberies, the proceeds from which the girl says she helped him to sell.
