TERCENTENARY OF HUDSON BAY DISCOVERY

Three Hundred Years Ago Henry Hudson Arrived in His Little Vessel

Winnipeg, Man., Aug. 3.—Three hundred years ago today Henry Hudson arrived in his little vessel, the Discovery, off Cape Wolstenholme, and on the following day he sailed into Hudson Bay, the great Ontario sea which now bears his name. Although the tercentenary of the discovery will pass with little formal observance, it is marked with the beginning of a movement which will soon make Hudson Bay loom large in the commerce of the world. The construction of the government railway to Hudson Bay this year has been commenced with the letting of a contract for the construction of a bridge across the Saskatchewan river at Lapas Junction, the present terminus of the Canadian Northern.

Within a year and a half the whistle of the locomotive will be heard on the shores of Hudson Bay, and Western Canadian wheat growers will be shipping their grain to Europe by way of Hudson Bay. It is expected that this will result in a great saving in freight and will result in a great increase in the grain output in the western part of the Dominion.

Hudson's voyage three hundred years ago, on which he discovered the great bay which is now to be opened to the shipping of the world, was for the purpose of finding a passage to the East. As Magellan had discovered a route around the southern extremity, so Hudson hoped to discover a way to the Orient between the land of the American continent and the great ice fields of the North. Hudson passed the winter of 1610 on the shores of Hudson Bay. He had much trouble with his crew. The trouble ended when Hudson was cast adrift in an open boat, and there is no doubt that the great discoverer died on Ontario's shores on in the waters of Hudson Bay.

So far, Canada has no permanent memorial to the man who played so large a part in her early history. A movement has been set on foot to rectify this ingratitude, and it is possible that next year, the tercentenary of his death, the completion of a railroad to Hudson Bay will offer an opportunity for the erection of a monument to his memory.

APPORTIONMENT

IS \$329,744.64.

Largest Ever Made in State—Each County Gets \$1.92 for Each Child of School Age

Salem, Or., Aug. 3.—State Treasurer Steele has made the largest annual apportionment of the income of the common school fund to the several counties that has ever been made in the state of Oregon. The amount was \$329,744.64, which was so apportioned that every county received \$1.92 for each child within its boundaries for school age; that is, between the ages of 4 and 20 years. The total number of school children in the state as reported by the county school superintendents of the different counties was found to be 171,742.

Apportionment Last Year

On August 1 last year the amount apportioned was \$308,300.65, which was the largest sum up to that time ever apportioned. The number of school children a year ago, according to the school census taken by the county superintendents, was 166,649 for the entire state, an increase for 1910 of 5,093. The rate apportioned a year ago was \$1.85 for each child of school age within the county, as against \$1.92 today.

Under the new apportionment, of course Multnomah leads with the largest school population. Her school population is 39,634 and her allotment of school money is \$76,097.23. Marion is second with a total population of 11,753 and an apportionment of \$22,565.76. Lane is third with a school population of 10,492 and a corresponding apportionment of \$20,144.64. Clackamas is fourth with a school population of 9,508 and an apportionment of \$18,255.36.
