SOLDIER BOYS ARE HOME FROM CAMP

A Tired Bunch, But Each Man Feels That Encampment Has Done Him Good

Companies A and C arrived home last evening from their annual encampment with the regulars at American Lake. The bunch was tired, dirty, and glad to get back home and get a good bath, even though the honors of war were great and the game exciting. Paraphernalia and accoutrements were quickly checked in and the boys turned loose.

The camp was struck yesterday morning at 6 o'clock and the companies entrained on the first section out of American Lake. Arrived in Portland about 3 the companies pulled out a little after 5. The journey home was uneventful. However, the companies know a great deal more about war than they did before and have learned many things which will make them useful in a case of emergency.

Before leaving, the Oregonians were complimented by the commanding officer, General Maus, upon the excellent work that had been performed. The General remarked that the two commands were among the best that he had ever seen from any state. He was especially pleased with the stamina displayed in the field and with the serious attention to details that was displayed by officers and men, he said.

HOP PREDICTION IS MADE FOR VALLEY

Inspection of Crop Made and The Conditions are Enumerated Here

After making a thorough inspection of hop ranches in the valley, Joseph Harris of this city returns to give an estimate of from \$5,000 to 105,000 pounds of the crop. He varies a little from some of the buyers, stating that, in his estimation, conditions will make the crop about as he estimates.

Harris is urging clean picking all the time as a result of a bombardment he has received from his people in the east, and he is confident if the hops are not picked clean that the sale of Oregon hops will be nipped in the bud. The market is quiet, he states, and contracting is slack. Statesman.

\$1.50 F. O. B. PAID FOR ROSEBURG PEARS

Roseburg, Or., Aug. 18.—Three carloads of pears grown in Eden-bower orchards this year have just been shipped east by E. M. McKeany of the Producers' Fruit company of Sacramento. Mr. McKeany pronounced the pears grown here fully equal to the Rogue river product and better than those grown north of this county. The Edenbower growers were paid \$1.50 per box f. o. b. cars at Roseburg, which is considered a satisfactory figure.

Besides these, other growers have shipped east this season five cars of pears from Winston (Green's station), six cars from Dillard and one car from Myrtle Creek. No returns have yet been received from pears good prices are expected.

Mr. McKeany, who handled the Edenbower pears, goes from here to Eugene and Salem to look after other fruit shipments, but will return here later to ship late pears and apples. There is an active demand for Douglas county fruit, as buyers have learned that its quality is unequalled anywhere.
