Great Railroad Builder No Confidence in the Future

St. Paul, Sept. 21.—James J. Hill, the "Empire Builder," the "Father of the Northwest," cannot see why the business men of the country should at present fear to engage in new enterprises, nor can he see any reason whatever for the semi-pessimism which is gradually creeping over the United States.

"It's only a temporary lack of confidence," said Mr. Hill, in an interview just given out.

"It's just like a flock of sheep. If one starts to run, every sheep in the flock will follow, even if they die for it."
