CRESWELL PRUNE HARVEST IS COMPLETE

Dr. Scarbrough Has 350,000 Pounds of Dried Fruit This Year

Monday noon work was finished in the prune driers belonging to L. D. Scarbrough and Mr. Scarbrough states that he will have 350,000 pounds of the dried fruit. The harvesting of the crop lasted three weeks and an average of 100 people have been employed daily since the season opened. This year's fruit is excellent and the crop is good. The amount of fruit lost in the fire of the Cottage Grove drier and in the orchards owing to rapid ripening will no doubt reach 25,000 pounds. Outside of this loss the crop was handled in good shape and turned out a high grade of dried fruit.

The 350,000 pounds made seven cars here and when shipped by the 40,000 pounds constitute a car with them. Mr. Scarbrough sold to H. G. Gile & Co. of Salem and Roseburg. The prune crop this year was only an average crop under favorable conditions and is no larger than that of 1908. Mr. Scarbrough and son, E. E. Scarbrough, give first class care to their orchards from the time cultivation starts until harvest is over, and as a result get a high grade article of fruit.

Other Creswell News.
Leo Martin and Will Schmitt were each fined \$25 and cost, \$26.25 in all, in Eugene, last week, for killing pheasants out of season. Mr. Martin shot the birds while accompanying Mr. Schmitt to the Martin place north of town, and the birds were put in Mr. Schmitt's wagon. The law held that Mr. Schmitt was equally guilty, as he had them in his possession.

The A. C. Bohrnstedt Orchard company are this week harvesting the apples in the Scarbrough orchard, which the company is handling this year. They expect to have three cars of merchantable apples off of 20 acres, 13 of which are bearing. The fruit will be marketed by the Fruit Association of Eugene. The apples will be wrapped and packed under the supervision of an excellent packer.

Messrs Moon and Russell, candidates for sheriff and county clerk respectively, were in attendance at the dedication exercises of the new school house Monday night.—Chronicle.
