HORNER WILL RUN AGAINST ALDERMAN O. A. C. Professor Pitted Against University of Oregon Man

A telegram from Secretary of State Benson this morning brought Professor J. B. Horner the official information that at the recent primaries he had been named as the Democratic nominee for state superintendent of public instruction, says the Corvallis Gazette-Times.

This was a poser for Professor Horner. Though he was occasionally mentioned as a fitting man for that position, and was solicited to announce himself before the people, Professor Horner refused to let the little bee get into his bonnet and in every reasonable way discouraged the friendly advances made. In interviews published in the Portland and Corvallis papers, Professor Horner made it clear that he preferred his work at O. A. C. and was not looking for political advancement.

But the Democrats named him as their choice to make the race against Alderman, so Professor Horner was in a quandary this morning. After consulting with some of his friends he was advised to get into the race and stay in it to the end. Professor Horner decided to do so, and is now a full-fledged candidate. The G-T predicts that he will roll up a mighty good vote, and stands a chance of beating the assembly nominee.
