**FIFTEEN DIFFERENT TEAMS OF BASKETBALL**

With no less than 15 different basketball teams playing daily on the big gym floor at the University, the material from which Trainer Hayward will have to pick his varsity squad is exceedingly promising.

There are more than a hundred students playing from whom the first team can be chosen. The great interest that is shown in the game this year is the result of several series of games that have been arranged between the fraternities and classes, with loving-cups as prizes. Never has so much enthusiasm been shown in the indoor game at the University as this year.

All of last year's team, with the exception of one, is back. There is much new material, which includes Carl Fenton, the big centre that toured the United States on the famous Oregon team of Dallas. The prospects are for a successful basketball season at the University. The school has never held the Northwest championship in this sport, principally because of its lack of facilities, but this year the outlook for this attainment is encouraging.

The inter-fraternity series has by a process of percentages practically eliminated all but the Sigma Chi, the Sigma Nu and the Beta Theta Pi. These three will fight for the cup.

After the Christmas vacation the candidates for the first, second and subsequent teams will be chosen.

**JOHNSON WILL MEET THE WINNER OF COMING FIGHT**

Chicago, Dec. 12.—Champion Jack Johnson, conqueror of James J. Jeffries, today agreed to meet the winner of the Langford-Jennette bout, scheduled to take place in France, in February, in a 25-round bout before the Wagonier club, of Paris, next spring.

Johnson will receive \$25,000 as his end of the purse.

The only condition imposed by the champion in agreeing to the match is that the \$25,000 which is to be his share of the stake, win, lose or draw, shall be posted in this country before he sails for Europe next March. The date for the battle probably will be set in April.

A cable message to this effect was sent to Al Lingo at once. Al Smith is named as the holder of the \$25,000 which is to be Johnson's end of the purse.
