HARRIS HAS CORNERED. PINK BEAN MARKET

Eugene Moving Picture Theatre
Owner Controls Commodity
in United States

Fred Harris, who jointly owns three moving picture theatres in Eugene with Ray M. Walker, seems to have a corner on pink beans. A Los Angeles paper says:

"According to a statement made today by its president, F. E. Harris, of the Louisiana Rice Milling company, a Los Angeles concern, has cornered the pink bean market of the United States. This means high prices—probably a little more than 7c a pound in Los Angeles, wholesale."

"Realizing that the market on pink beans would be firm, because of increased consumption, we began quietly to buy beans in large quantities some six weeks ago," said Mr.

Harris today. We have kept buying—were still buying today, in fact—until we now have at least one-fifth of the available pink beans in California. This means the United States, as no other state produces pink beans."

"To give figures, the beans in sight in the state total about 120,000 bags; we have about 25,000 bags."

"We began buying at \$4.00 a cwt., f. o. b. Los Angeles, and bought heavily at about that figure."

"The San Francisco brokers, who in previous years controlled the pink bean industry, were slow in buying. When they began, the cheap beans were gone and they had to pay higher prices. Pink beans are now worth \$8 per cwt. in Los Angeles."

"So we have the market cornered. If the San Francisco men try to undersell us, they will fail because we bought at such low figures that we can sell at lower figures than their buying prices and still make a handsome profit."

"What will beans sell for? Just

about what we want to ask. Not less than 7c a pound wholesale."

"We have the market where we want it. It is ten months before any more beans will be raised; in the meantime, the people must eat beans."

"The way we started to buy large quantities of beans was like this. We have been in the rice business for years and recently we noticed that sales were falling down. Why? We determined to find out."

"We found the reason was that much of the labor previously done by Orientals was being done by Mexicans. Mexicans don't eat rice—they eat pink beans. They are the Mexican bread."

"With more and more of these people coming here the consumption of pink beans must increase. Besides, many Americans and Europeans eat a great deal of pink beans."

"The people want the beans, and we have the beans. So putting two and two together, I gather that pink bean prices are going to be pretty high the next ten months."

NATIONAL FOREST TIMBER FOR SALE

Medford, Or., Dec. 11.—M. L. Ericson, supervisor of the Crater national forest, announced today that the forestry department is preparing to place 340,000,000 feet of timber on the market. Of this 150,000,000 feet is classified as burned over, and 150,000,000 as green. The sale price will be in the neighborhood of \$1.000 000.

The offering of the green timber along with the burned over, is to give an added inducement to buyers. Much of the green timber is said to be ripe, and should be cut in order to avoid waste from decay. On the other hand, only a small percentage of the trees in the fire-swept district are dead.

In order to log the timber to be sold a total of 45 miles of railroad must be built, one road of 15 miles from the south fork of the Rogue river to Butte Falls, two of ten miles each from Clover creek to Klamath river, and from Elk river to Rogue river.

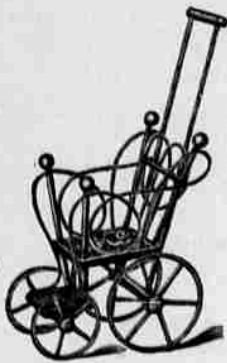
