### WOLGAST WANTS TO FIGHT OWEN MORAN

Cadillac, Mich., Dec. 20.—When shown the challenge issued to him last night by Owen Moran, of England, Ad Wolgast, lightweight champion, said today:

"I will fight Moran for the Championship and \$5000 side bet within 30 days after the date of his challenge to me. The fight must be not less than 45 rounds, or to a finish. The weight must be 133 pounds ring-side, and my end of the purse must be not less than \$12,500, regardless of the result.

"These are my conditions, and nothing will change them. I won't risk the championship against a lightweight contest in less than 45 rounds. It makes no difference to me where the fight takes place."

Soon after Moran defeated Nelson, Wolgast said he would meet the British fighter immediately, but later changed the date to February, with a \$12,500 guarantee.

### O. A. C. WILL PLAY ANY BUT OREGON

Oregon Agricultural College, Corvallis, Dec. 20.—Despite the reports which have appeared to the contrary, the Oregon Agricultural College basketball team will this season meet all the representatives of the conference except the University of Oregon, although the Oregon Agricultural College representative was not present at the Seattle conference and the games with the conference college will not be played according to the regular conference schedule.

The first game with conference colleges in which the O. A. C. five will be represented will be played at Corvallis on the evening of February 16 with the University of Washington.
