Sealed bids will be received for furnishing and delivering on the campus of the University of Oregon, other 1000 cords of old growth body fir wood, 4 feet long, split large size, or 1200 cords of slab wood, 4 feet long; also 300 cords of second-growth fir, 4 feet long; fuel to be delivered not later than Sept. 15th, 1911. Bids are invited on the whole amount required, or any portion thereof.

Bids must be filed in the University administration office with the secretary of the board of regents not later than two o'clock p. m. on February 21st, 1911, at which time they will be opened by the president of the university and the secretary of the board. Parties proposing to furnish fuel are invited to be present at that time in the administration office in Villard hall.

A certified check in the sum of 5 per cent of the amount of the bid must accompany each bid, the University reserving the right to reject any or all bids.

PROMINENT PORTLAND BUSINESS MAN DEAD

Portland, Feb. 20.—William Harrison Corbett, president and manager of the Willamette Iron & Steel Works, died at 4:15 this morning in his home, 618 Kearney street.

Mr. Corbett was convalescing from an attack of pneumonia, and was thought to have passed the crisis. The physique that withstood fever failed to tide the weakening period following, and when heart action grew very weak early in the morning, there was not enough strength remaining to rally. With the attending physicians, Dr. E. J. LaBbe and Ernest Tucker, doing all within the knowledge of medical science, the patient sank steadily until beyond aid.

Death of Portland's ironmaster caused a profound sensation of regret in local business circles. Mr. Corbett was regarded as one of the most powerful and aggressive business factors enlisted for the building of greater Portland.
