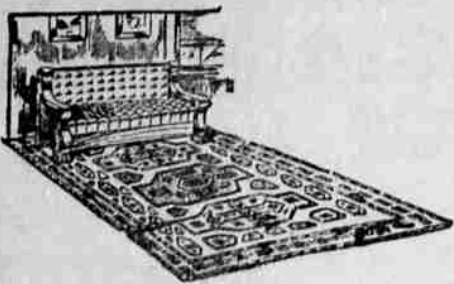

### WHITMAN PLAYS HERE NEXT WEDNESDAY

The baseball season at the University will formally open in inter-collegiate series next Wednesday when Whitman University plays the first of two games here. Oregon will begin the game with a team of unknown strength. Because of the large number of new men, there has been little chance to get a line on comparative strength, and there has been much speculation upon Oregon's prospects. There is much uncertainty in regard to the three new pitchers, Cousins, Houck and Peet, for although they are showing up well in practice they may fall down under the stress of the game. The team is much stronger than last year in every other department.

The following men will compose the team that will play: Word and Taylor, catchers; Peet and Cousins, pitchers; Jamison, first base; Newland and Fenton, second base; Annison and Dobie, short-stop; Roberts, third base; Chandler, VanMarter, Mount, Harboure, Cobb and Stannard, for the outfield.

## COAST RANGE CO. BUYING MUCH TIMBER LAND

Have Enough Now to Keep the Mill Running 15 Years and Are Securing More

The Coast Range Lumber company, which recently took over the holdings of the Sunset Lumber company, including the big mill at Mabel, on the Mohawk, is buying much timber land in addition to that already owned by the old company. Yesterday afternoon a deed for the transfer of 692 acres by John F. Kelly, of the Booth-Kelly Lumber company, and Mrs. Theresa Jackson, his sister, to the new company, was filed with the county clerk for record. The consideration given in the deed is \$45,000. At the same time several other deeds were filed conveying smaller tracts from different persons to the company.

The company has bonded its properties for \$350,000 and now has ample money to operate on a large scale. All of the claims against the old company have been paid off and the work of making extensive improvements in the sawmill plant has begun.

### PHEASANTS TO THROG

### STATE OWNED LAND

Salem, Or., April 3.—Governor West has announced that arrangements are being made for putting into use at once the new law authorizing creation of wild game and bird preserves on state-owned lands, and that through business firms in Portland, who have agents in China, large importations of China pheasants will be made to these preserves at once. For two years China pheasants are protected by law and the governor believes that by the end of that period pheasants will be plentiful in Oregon. The asylum farm will be utilized at once for breeding both China and Reeves pheasants. The governor says that one patient at the asylum farm spends his whole time catching squirrels, and such patients, he thinks, can be instructed in the work of propagating wild game birds with profit to the state.

### MEDFORD MERCHANTS GET REBATE FROM S. P.

Medford, Or., April 6.—The Southern Pacific company has issued a call in this city for the freight bills on which refunds are due after lowering of rates on shipments between this city and Portland. The refunds cover the period between the time the state railroad commission ordered the lower tariff into effect and the upholding of that order by the federal court.

To expedite the work the bills will be forwarded to San Francisco and paid from that office. It is estimated that \$10,000 is due shippers in this city. The period covered is from October to February.
