### LOTS OF EARLY GOOD THINGS TO EAT IN EUGENE'S MARKETS

Southern Strawberries, Asparagus, Cauliflower and Rhubarb Tempt Housewife

Oh, you ripe, juicy strawberry! California and southern strawberries, real berries, too, made their first appearance in the Eugene stores during the week, and are tempting the housewife toward luxury. They are only 1 cent a bite. Twenty-five strawberries for 25 cents, just like eating money. But they taste every bit as good as the copper. California strawberries are still a little early yet and some of the berries in the shop windows are from the fields of Louisiana. When strawberries are shipped 2000 miles or more no wonder they cost two bits a box.

Home-grown asparagus as made its first appearance in the grocery stores, and local grown rhubarb of the best grade is in the store windows.

The feed and buy markets have remained practically the same during the past week, but a change upward is expected in prices during the next six days. This is based upon the large amount of construction work and spring work that is increasing the demand rapidly. The prices are already far from low, barley now being quoted at 30 1/2 cents.

In the meat market there has been little change. Pork and veal have fallen off as a result of a fluctuation in the demand, but the change is slight. Prices at the various markets are varying between a considerable range, and it is hard to quote a retail price.

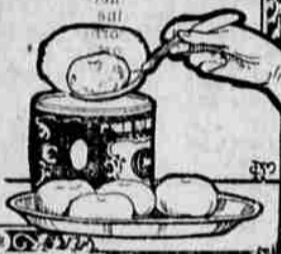
