TALK OF RECALL
AGAINST JUDGE COKE

Rumors current about town today were that petitions are to be placed in circulation at once, demanding the recall of Judge John S. Coke, of Marshfield, from the circuit bench of this district. Public feeling over the apparent one-sided instructions in the McClallen trial continues strong, and this has seemingly crystallized into a demand, of doubtful proportions, for Judge Coke's retirement. Added to this is the wrath of radical anti-prohibitionists over the heavy fines imposed on convicted beer sellers and this element is expected to support the petitions. For all that, the success of the movement is none too sure. The district is a big one and the majority of the citizens may hesitate to oust a public official whose fearlessness and integrity are unquestioned. The recall law is a splendid weapon for a betrayed constituency, but it should be used against the judiciary with caution and judgment.—Roseburg Review.

FARMERS ARE HAVING
HOME NAMES REGISTERED

Four in Lane County Have So Far Taken Advantage of New Law

So far, since the new law went into effect on the 20th of May, owners of four farms in Lane county, have registered the names of their places with the secretary of state. It is necessary to make application to the county clerk, who forwards it to the secretary of state and if the name selected is not duplicated by someone else if it is registered. The following Lane county farm owners have had their farm names registered: Fred Fisk, "Boulders," in section 36, township 21, south of range 3 east; M. J. Harper, "Midland," in section 15, township 16, south of range 4 west; A. E. Young, "Fairview Ranch," section 7 township 18 south of range 3 west; W. F. Smith, "Mt. Vernon," sections 3, 4 and 9, township 18 south of range 2 west.

George Melvin Miller has filed application to register the name "Morning Glory" for a farm of 646 acres owned by him in township 16 south of range 3 west. "Twin Maples" is the name selected by T. A. Shafer for his farm in section 12, township 19, south of range 3 west.

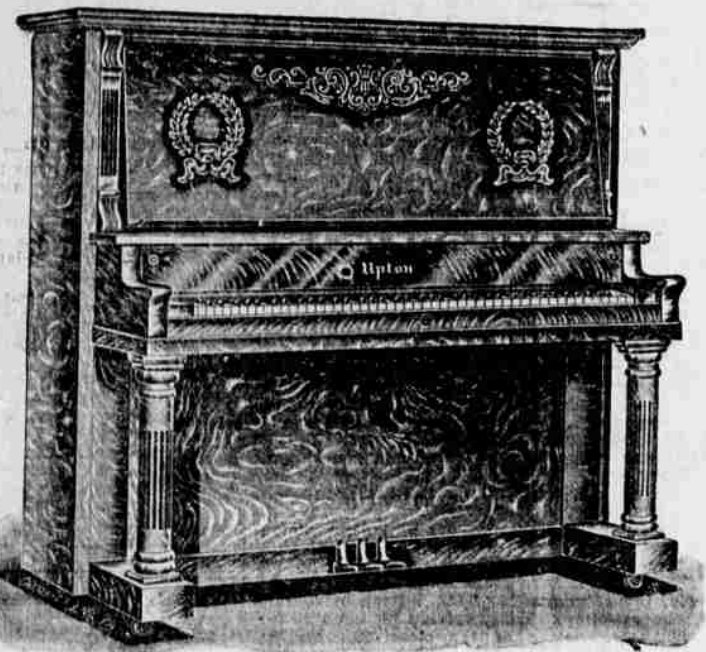

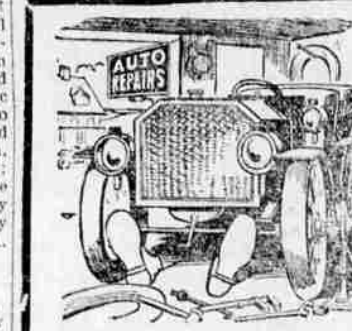
