STUDENT AFFAIRS ALL UNDER ONE MANAGEMENT

All Branches Will Hereafter be Controlled by Single Graduate Manager

By the force of an amendment that was passed by the students of the University of Oregon yesterday, hereafter all the student activities including football, baseball, basketball, debating, oratory, track and tennis and excepting the publication of the Emerald and the management of the Glee club will be controlled by a single graduate manager who shall be paid an adequate salary by the students. This is a substitute for the system where each activity has a student manager elected each year by the students. The old system has its value in the training of the few managers often at the expense of the students. The new system is expected to save its extra cost in addition to harmonize the activities both in the college and between the other colleges where diplomatic relations are desirable.

At this meeting of the student body nine debaters were granted "O's" the students' award of honor for the services rendered in debate. Three of these were girls. The following are the debaters: Miss Lila Clark, Miss Carrie Degermark, Chas. Robinson of Portland; Birdie Wise, of Astoria; Percy Collier and Leon Wray of Eugene; Carlton Spencer of Cottage Grove; and Verner Metchen, bacher of Klamath Falls.

An effort to elect a yell leader contrary to the rules of the executive committee failed because of lack of attendance at the student body meeting. There is general dissatisfaction to the present system where the yell leader is picked by the executive committee after a series of tryouts.

GOOD RECORD MADE BY SIUSLAW HEN

How is this for a small flock of hens? A flock of 12 leghorn pullets belonging to Joseph Eafey of Acme, in four months from January 16 to May 16 of this year, laid 860 eggs. At 25 cents per dozen, which is about the average price for eggs during that time, the income from the flock lacks but a few cents of \$18.00 or \$15.00 for each hen in four months. At that rate the income from a small flock of hens would purchase the supplies for a family.—Florance West.

HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS TO ATTEND ATHLETIC EVENTS FREE OF CHARGE

Amendment of Constitution Raising Student Body Tax From \$1.50 to \$2.00

To admit all the High school students free to the school activities, such as football games, track meets, debates and the like, is the plan that was adopted Saturday afternoon by the student body association in the form of an amendment to the constitution. In order to pay the expenses of the student activities the student body tax was raised from \$1.50 to \$2. This tax will be required from every High school student before he or she will be allowed to become a member of the student body association. This tax fund, then, which will total nearly \$1000, will be divided in definite proportions among the various activities. This amendment was passed by a body of students composed almost entirely of girls, only five or six boys taking part because of the wholesale suspension that took place Saturday on account of the "rally."

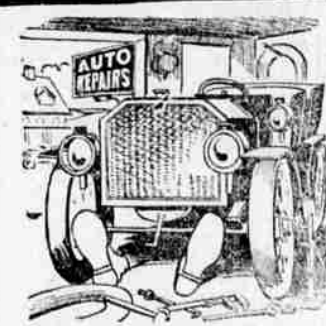
