

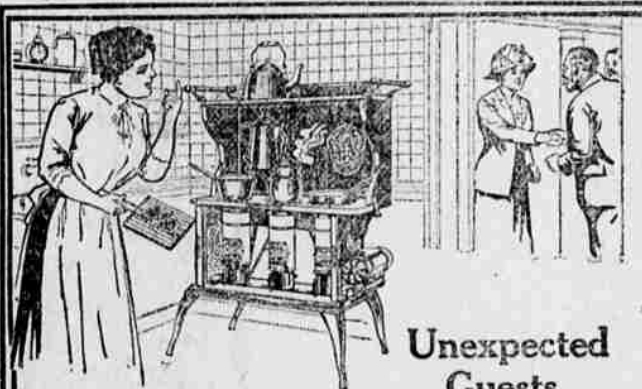

SECOND FIRE IN CHAMBERS' MILL

Cottage Grove Lumber Plant Has Blaze Costing Nearly \$10,000

Cottage Grove, Or., June 13.—A hoodoo has settled on the sawmill plant of J. H. Chambers, located one mile south of this city. The second fire within a fortnight broke out Saturday evening and totally destroyed the mill, but the larger portion of the lumber yard was saved, owing to a large force of men going from town and doing effective work. The crew had quit work for the day, and the night watchman had not come on when the fire started, and the mill was ablaze before any one knew it. The fire two weeks ago destroyed the planer and a portion of the yard, but favorable wind and hard fighting by a bucket brigade prevented the flames from spreading. The planer had been repaired and is being lined up ready for work again in the near future, and was saved from the ravages of the second fire. It is understood that Chambers will rebuild the sawmill in the near future. The loss is estimated at near \$10,000.

RUEF PLAYS ANGEL TO FELLOW CONVICTS

San Francisco, June 13.—The prisoners of San Quentin penitentiary have found an "angel" in the person of Abraham Ruef, San Francisco's former political boss, whose arrest and battle in the courts attracted the attention of the civilized world.

The management of the two California penitentiaries has been rigorous in its discipline but not over-severe and most conservative in the allowances permitted to filter forth from its forbidding walls.

There comes, however, the story of the good deeds of Ruef, of his determination to aid with his money and with the talents which have been given him, those men, his fellow prisoners, who are less fortunate than he and by reason of lost opportunities and lack of education, and refinement Ruef aided in financing a baseball team, the prison band and it is to be largely through his efforts that a sumptuous setting will be had for the annual vaudeville performance which occurs July 4.

The prison library has been enlarged through the efforts of the former boss and he is already looked up to, revered and respected by band whose names are spoken beneath a convict number. Yet, Ruef has not received his reward. For three months he has toiled in the jute mills.

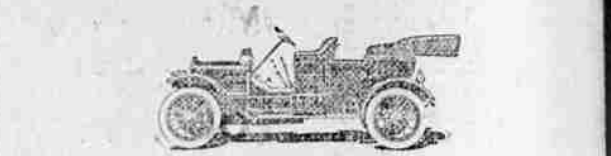
