PROF. HAWTHORNE RECEIVES HONORARY DEGREE OF LL. B.

Former Member of Faculty of University Honored by U. of O. Law School

As a measure of recognition of his long and faithful service on the faculty, and in honor of his admission to the bar, Professor Benjamin James Hawthorne on his 74th birthday yesterday had conferred upon him the honorary degree of LL. B. by the University of Oregon law school. The recommendation of Judge C. U. Gantenbein, dean of the school, that this degree be granted, was unanimously concurred in by the university faculty.

A confederate soldier when he was 24 years of age, college professor and president in turn for 45 years, professor emeritus and recipient of Carnegie's pension fund honors, Professor Hawthorne became a law student at the age of 73 and now occupies a desk in the law offices of Smith & Woodcock in Eugene.

Professor Hawthorne was born in Lunenburg, Va., June 19, 1837, and enlisted with the 18th Virginia Confederate Infantry. He was colonel at the battle of Gettysburg on the staff of General Armistead, and when his commander fell dead by his side in Pickett's famous charge he fought on, though severely wounded himself, to the finish.
