PASS CREEK CANYON NO LONGER ONLY HIGHWAY

Shorter Route Through Calapooia Mountains Combines Pleasure of Visit

Cottage Grove Sentinel: Automobile tourists will learn with no small degree of satisfaction that the road south from Cottage Grove has been made easily passable via London Springs, thus avoiding the treacherous roads that through the Pass Creek canyon, in which many machines have been hopelessly stuck during the past spring and summer.

The residents of London, at the instance of the Calapooia Springs company, whose mineral springs and resort hotel is at that place, spent several hundred dollars improving the highway over the Calapooia Mountains as an inducement for automobilists to take the Cottage Grove-Oakland route instead of the old one by Pass Creek, through Drain. Not only is the road much better, since the completion of the improvements, but the route is fully eight miles shorter and pleasure parties are afforded the opportunity of stopping at the resort while en route. UNIVERSITY CAMPUS BEAUTIFUL SIGHT

Six Hundred Rose Plants in Full Bloom are Very Attractive

Six hundred rose plants on the University of Oregon campus are in full bloom and are requiring almost the entire attention of a gardener to keep the full blown roses out. Each day it is necessary to cut from five to six roses off of each plant. The total number of something over 3000 roses that are cut each day make several wheelbarrow loads. The roses form hedges along each walk and drive throughout the campus.

The campus is prettier than it has ever been before. For the first time practically the whole tract is in lawn and cut by a force of gardeners. Until this year about two square blocks were allowed to grow without attention. These now are a solid lawn of green. The University power plant pumps water for irrigation and some 30 sprinklers are in operation all during the day. The campus roses and flower beds are under the supervision of H. M. Fisher, head gardener. He takes great pride in the appearance of the grounds.
