STUDYING WAR AT CLACKAMAS STATION

Officers of Oregon National Guard Taking Part in Maneuvers

Portland, July 13.—Theoretical warfare was waged in earnest in the vicinity of the Clackamas station rifle range yesterday by the 100 commissioned officers of the national guard who are attending camp of special instruction conducted by a detail of officers from the First United States Infantry. Some of the fine points in the subtle art of slaughtering a troublesome enemy were gone into during the day. Half a dozen minor engagements were planned and fought in theory, the officers marching for miles in the working out of the problems given them for solution.

Map-reading and reconnaissance were the principal subjects of study. Map-reading was taken up in the forenoon and gone into exhaustively, the importance of accuracy and exact knowledge in handling field maps being strongly impressed upon all. It was pointed out that a small mistake in reading a military map may result not only in the annihilation of the offending regiment, but possibly in the defeat of the entire force involved.

Detailed maps of the whole district for miles about had been prepared previously after weeks of labor by officers of the army. It was shown that by these maps, which appear meaningless at first glance, the expert may get instantly a correct understanding of the nature of the region quite as clearly as from a great panoramic photograph.

Reconnaissance was taken up in the afternoon in a series of tactical walks. The problems were simple, involving the conduct of small patrols out for information of the enemy. While the guardsmen showed a thorough knowledge of the subject much valuable information was obtained from the expert regulars who keep abreast of all the late wrinkles in the exact science of warfare. Sixty non-commissioned officers are receiving instruction at the same time under a detail of non-commissioned officers from Vancouver barracks. Practical instruction work relating to their duties in camp and in the fields was given these men during the day.

EUGENE MAN HELPS TO DISCOVER MINERAL DEPOSIT NEAR ROSEBURG

Roseburg, Or., July 13.—A deposit of kaolin has been discovered in the mountains about 25 miles east of Roseburg. Kaolin is a high grade of clay. It is the chief material used in the manufacture of the finest chinaware and general porcelain goods and an industry of immense proportions may result from the discovery.

It is said there is only one other known deposit of kaolin in the United States, in Colorado. This has not proved productive enough to supply the domestic demand and in consequence large quantities of the soil have been imported from China. With the home demand greatly exceeding the available supply, the possibilities for the operation of the kaolin industry in this county on a large scale will readily be seen.

The discovery was made by Dr. W. E. Gillespie, of Eugene. A sample of the soil sent to the Oregon Agricultural college for analysis brought the information that it was kaolin of the highest quality. Dr. Gillespie interested a number of Eugene and Roseburg friends and claims were surveyed and staked and location filings tendered to the county clerk's office.
