OREGON'S NEW MOTOR LAW IN EFFECT

Motorists Declare It Ideal for Regulation and Registration of Autos.

Portland, Or., August 1.—What is declared by motorists to be an ideal law for the regulation, registration, license, identification and operation of automobiles went into effect in Oregon today. The law applies to every motor vehicle in the state, and includes provisions to regulate and license persons who drive and own cars and provides adequate penalties for the violations of the act. The new law limits the authority of cities, towns and counties to regulate automobiles and repeals all municipal acts or parts of acts which conflict with the state law. Professional chauffeurs are required to pass state examinations and to register with the secretary of state. Road rules are provided to govern all highways. Road races are prohibited unless given official sanction and provision made for adequate patrolling of the course. Joy riders who use cars not their own are to be punished by imprisonment not exceeding two years. A new system of taxation of motor vehicles is inaugurated, ranging from \$3 for motorcycles and automobiles up to twenty-eight horse power to \$10 for forty horse power cars. Including in the act are twenty-five laws of the road for the motorist, and should he forget any of these he becomes subject to a heavy fine.

NEW EXPRESS RATES IN EFFECT TODAY

General Reduction Made by All Express Companies of Country.

Washington, August 1.—A general reduction in rates was put in effect today by practically all of the express companies operating in the United States. The filing of the new tariffs followed the announcement of the Interstate Commerce commission that a thorough probe would be made into the rates, classifications, regulations and practices of the express concerns. A growing fear of parcels post legislation may also have influenced the express officials to reduce their rates. The reduction put into effect today are sweeping, and in the case of long hauls to non-competitive points the cut is especially deep. About ninety per cent of all express traffic in the United States is affected. The double graduate system of charging for packages under 100 pounds weight is abandoned. The new tariffs, however, will not change the plans of the Interstate Commerce commission to undertake a thorough investigation. Examiners will be sent all over the country and the books of the companies will be thoroughly searched.
