CHICAGO GRAIN MARKETS Chicago, Oct. 21.—Grain prices went higher on the Chicago Board of Trade today because of scant offerings and increase in the export demand. Provisions were irregular, December wheat opened up 1c at 105 and closed 3c higher. May wheat opened at 109 up 1-4 and closed 2 1/2 higher.

Motor Vehicles Increase In Number in Oregon Salem, Ore., Oct. 21.—There were 118,732 motor vehicles, 2968 motorcycles, 5200 chauffeurs, 175,152 operators and 508 motor vehicle dealers licensed in Oregon up to September 15 of this year, according to a report prepared by Sam A. Kozar, secretary of state.

ALBERS ESTATE \$41,837 Oregon City, Ore., Oct. 21.—The estate of the late Henry Albers is valued at \$41,837.98, according to an inventory filed in the office of County Clerk Miller today. The estate consists of personal property valued at \$20,737.98 and real property valued at \$21,099.90. Included in the personal property are 3192 shares of Albers Brothers' Milling company stock, which are listed as of no value for the reason that they are held as collateral for the full extent of their par value.

Lower Minimum Wage for Washington Women Voted Olympia, Wash., Oct. 21.—Upsetting the minimum wage recommendation of \$13.20 for women in laundries, mercantile and other industries, a minimum wage of \$12 a week was recommended for women in manufacturing industries yesterday by conference representing employers, employees and the public. The scale had been decided on by the conference by a vote of 5 to 4.
