EUGENE H. S. LEADS IN NEW STUDENTS AT 'U'

The Eugene high school leads all others of the state in number of new students enrolled in the University of Oregon during the last term, according to the report of the registrar's office. There were 2012 students enrolled in the University of Oregon and 842 were new students. Of the new students enrolling 628 came from high schools of the state, Eugene high school enrolled 67 and the Portland high schools ranked next.

From counties there 57 from Lincoln, 56 from Jefferson, 52 from Washington, Salem high school had the next largest number of representatives with 28. Those which followed next in order were: Astoria with 18, Baker 14, Oregon City 13, and Pendleton with 12. There were 202 new students from high schools outside of Oregon. Washington sent 62, the largest number. California has 44 entered here, and Idaho is next with 15. Eleven students came to the University from

schools outside the United States or from territorial possessions. Of the 830 new undergraduates accounted for, 150 had college work before coming to this University.

Grocer Saves Wallet by Hiding It from Bandits

Seattle, Jan. 10.—Three bandits were sought by the police today after the robbery of a garage man and a grocer last night. W. C. Fitzpatrick, grocer, was

held up by two masked bandits. When confronted by the men, he resisted but was overpowered. He was dragged into a side room, where he managed to slip his wallet containing \$110 out of his pocket and toss it into a corner. The bandits searched him and took \$15. From the cash register they took \$10 and fled to the street.

A young bandit, dressed in army trousers, held up H. M. Stacks, in a garage. Stacks was backed up against an

automobile and chained to the wheel. His pockets yielded \$11. As he arrived just after the bandit and Stacks by filing the bank.
