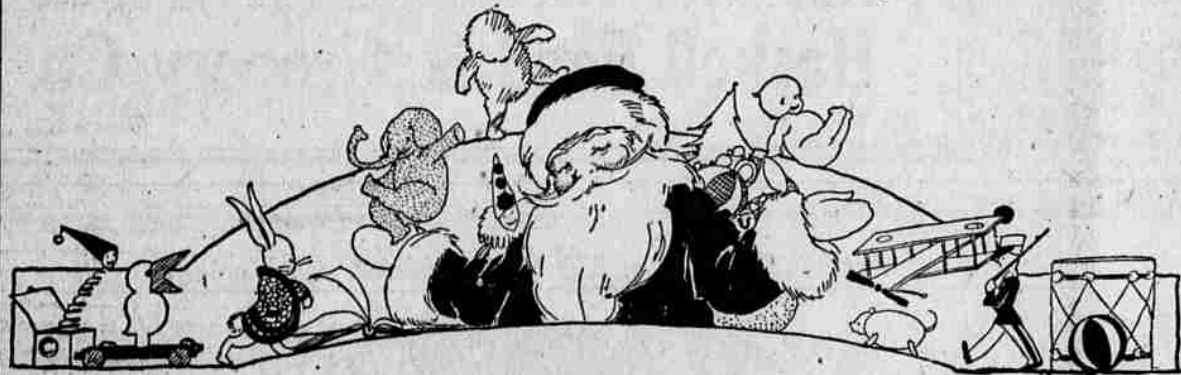

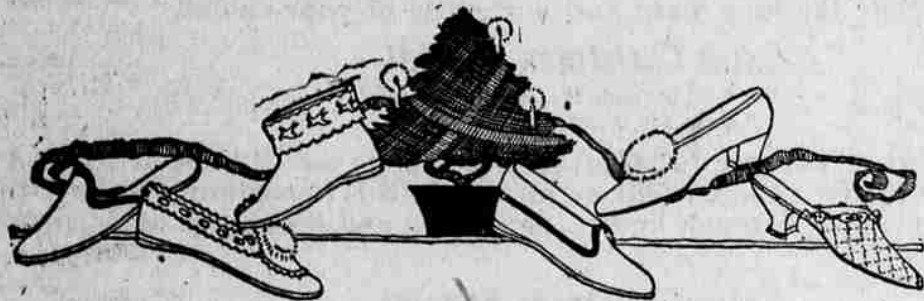

BIG INHERITANCE TAX Salem, Dec. 21.—A check for \$31,052.40 was received by State Treasurer O. F. Hoff here Tuesday from the N. Y. Wheeler estate in payment of the inheritance tax due from that estate. Holdings of which in Oregon are valued at \$1,345,598.83. Of the amount remitted \$57,041.50 represented the tax due

and \$698.65 interest on the deferred payment. N. P. Wheeler, a resident of Endeavor, Pa., died March 2, 1926. The inheritance tax has been in controversy since that time.
