Four prisoners were halted in their task of digging their way through the brick walls of the county jail Sunday morning shortly after midnight when Sheriff Stickle, City Patrolman Dugan and Young and Traffic Officer Humphrey rushed through the front door and placed them back in the steel cells. The men had been left in the corridor that they might have a chance to sleep near the big stove, the night being cold.

An outside guard, retained when the Florence bank bandits were first arrested and maintained even since they were sent to Salem, heard the noise some time before midnight and made his report. Officers were gathered and the "party" stopped.

Eight inches of brick had been chiseled out with a bar and a butcher knife, after an iron plate had been bent back from the wall just above the floor in the rear of the jail. Another hour would have seen the men free, it is believed. One was so engrossed in his task he did not know the officers had entered, and did not stop until one tapped his foot and told him it was quitting time.
