Wear a poppy on Memorial day to honor those who gave their lives in the World war, but more than that, bring comfort to the families and little children needing assistance as a result of the inability of their father to care for them is the plea of women's auxiliaries of American Legion posts all over the United States who will sponsor Poppy Week before May 30. Locally, the auxiliary will have poppies for sale beginning Friday, May 23, until Memorial day. The colorful flowers which will appear by the thousands are being made in government hospitals all over the country by disabled soldiers. The choice of the poppy to wear on Memorial day as the emblem of tribute to those who made the supreme sacrifice in foreign fields not only affords a most fitting symbol but serves a

constructive purpose in providing employment to the soldiers still in hospitals and facing a handicapped existence. 'Poppy Week, it is hoped, will become an annual affair, just as the sale of seals at Christmas time has become fixed in the minds of the public as a very definite aid in stamping out the white plague.

The national society of the United States Daughters of 1812 will be represented by its members in Oregon who will place the official grave marker for the soldiers of the war of 1812 upon the grave of Mr. Huliu, father of L. G. Huliu, of this city, who is now in Claremont, California. The ceremony will take place Fri-

day afternoon at two o'clock in the Odd Fellows cemetery and will be conducted by state officers of the society, assisted by the Daughters of the American Revolution. The public is invited to the service. Three graves of soldiers of the war of 1812 have been marked in the state by the Oregon society. Mrs. Jobs, who is state president, will be glad to meet any women eligible to membership in the society at the Osburn hotel Friday afternoon from four until five o'clock. Lewis and Clark chapter of the D. A. R. has received Mrs. Jobs' invitation to take part in the ceremony and several of their members will be present at the service.

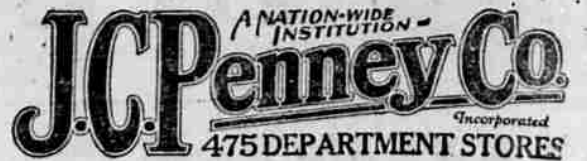
