SECRET PACT HELD CAUSE OF KILLING 19-YEAR-OLD GIRL

BENTON HARBOR, Mich., Aug. 14.—Florence McKinney, the pretty 19-year-old sweetheart of Emil Zupke, today is charged by Sheriff George Bridgeman with being the instigator of a secret pact that resulted in the murder of Cora May Raber.

Hit by hit, according to the sheriff, the laughing country girl has admitted that she knew her rival for Zupke's affections was to "be done away with."

"I knew it all the time," she is quoted as saying. "I knew when I went riding with Cora and Emil that she never would return alive."

Zupke and the girl were arrested Tuesday night, after he had admitted that he had choked Miss Raber to death and his sweetheart had voluntarily surrendered and confessed that she was with him when the crime was committed. Zupke related how he choked Miss Raber, who was soon to become a mother, after she had refused to release him from a promise to marry her so he could wed Miss McKinney. He choked her, he declared, as they were driving through a desolate country near here, while Miss McKinney was at the wheel of his roadster.

Zupke and his youthful sweetheart today face first degree murder charges.

PLAN FOR OPENING OF WEST SIDE WAY

Last of the concrete on the West Side highway, on the stretch from the Benton county line to Monmouth, was laid last Saturday, according to a letter received at the local Chamber of Commerce from Charles C. Powell, secretary of the Monmouth Commercial club. Formal opening of the stretch of new pavement will take place some time early in September, according to the information in the letter.

At the present time a detour from the Benton county line to Monmouth is in effect. When the ten-mile detour is abandoned, a second highway, paved all the way, will be opened from Eugene to Portland.

Monmouth is planning for a huge celebration when the pavement is opened. All valley cities will be asked to join in the celebration.

Americans Break 3 Irish Records in Well-Staged Plays

DUBLIN, Aug. 14.—(AP)—J. J. H. of the United States, defeated O. by three games to one in the deciding match of a handball tournament of the Tuohem games today. O'Reilly was the first Irishman to win a single game from the Americans. Brennan of Ireland defeated O'Donnell of the United States.

The Dublin newspapers today comment enthusiastically on the performance of the American athletes in the track and field events yesterday, especially on the six victories of Harold M. Osborne of the Illinois A. C.

The Americans broke three Irish records. Further thrilling contests are expected today when Lavin, the Irish champion, will meet fleet Americans, Englishmen, Canadians, Australians and New Zealanders in the 400 metre run.

Liquor Smuggling Penalty Heavier Under Tariff Act

WASHINGTON, Aug. 14.—Instructions have been given by Attorney General Stone to United States attorneys at coast and border points to employ the tariff act of 1922 preferably in prosecuting liquor smuggling cases because of the heavier penalties possible under it.

The department of justice last month announced its purpose with new facilities at its command, especially those granted by congress to the coast guard, to redouble its efforts to combat rum running.

Section 593 of the tariff act provides penalties of imprisonment and a fine of \$5000 to smugglers of goods, including whisky.

Missing Paymaster With \$5000 Hunted

SEATTLE, Aug. 14.—Inquiry into the disappearance of Lieut. Lester B. Karelle, a paymaster, who disappeared May 8 from the Puget Sound navy yard at Bremerton, near here, was reopened today on orders from Secretary Wilbur.

Extended search had failed to find any trace of Karelle or of \$5000 which was said to have disappeared.

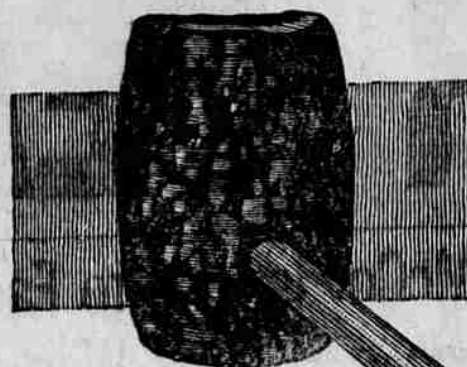
\$2,000 Purse Won By Taggart's Colt
