

ACKERMAN-HARRIS MONDAY AT HEILIG

"Tess of the D'Urbervilles" Coming to Heilig Thursday, for Three-Day Run, Is Fine Film

Portraying English life in all its details, with all the aches, the futile longings made by class distinction, "Tess of the D'Urbervilles" which comes to the Heilig Thursday, Friday and Saturday, is hailed as one of the striking cinema features of all time. The story of Tess, a brilliantly beautiful and clever English peasant girl who finds that she is the descendant of a famous English line—her consequent complicated love affairs with a fatal ending—is familiar to all who read modern books. The original was written by Thomas Hardy, the man, who, it is said, knew best the heart of the English people, big and little, royal and peasant. Into the picture, Blanche Sweet and Conrad Nagel have put the utmost of their art, and the result is their masterpiece, a picture praised by all critics.

Neilan has transferred this tale to the screen as the author wrote it. He has retained all the power, all the appeal, all the beauty of the original. The young director, who has so many film successes to his credit, has invested the dramatic progress of the story with a pictorial beauty that adds to its interest, and the development of the plot is done in scenes that gratify the eye as well as grip the mind.

Another advantage "Tess of the D'Urbervilles" has, is that the exterior scenes were photographed in authentic locations. Neilan made the rural episodes in the Hardy-Westsex country in England, which enforces the drama by having the absolutely correct atmosphere.

The only change from the original Neilan made has been to advance the time to the present day, which makes the story far more interesting for present day consumption. The director considers "Tess of the D'Urbervilles" to be a story fitting all time and consequently feels this is not taking a liberty.

Tess is one of the most pitied and beloved heroines in all literature. As she is portrayed by Blanche Sweet, the girl is invested with rare beauty and charm of personality that immediately wins unending sympathy.

Conrad Nagel, one of the most popular leading men appearing on the screen, is exactly suited to the role of Angel Clare and gives the finest acting performance of his career.

Stuart Holmes, whose screen villains are too numerous to mention, makes Alec D'Urberville, a real and convincing figure.

Von Tirpitz May Disclose Details Of Ship's Sinking

BERLIN, Oct. 25.—(AP)—Details hitherto unpublished concerning the inside facts leading up to the sinking of the Lusitania have been promised on a new book to be issued soon by Admiral von Tirpitz, the former navy head, who has been credited with having given the final order which resulted in the destruction of the steamer.

According to the announcements, Admiral von Tirpitz, new leader of the Nationalists in the Reichstag, has consented to the publication of all the secret archives in his possession, which cover some 20 years prior to 1914.

The first book of Admiral von Tirpitz appeared some years ago, and caused quite a stir despite its tone of reservation, but in the new volume the admiral, it is said, has promised to "tell it all."

Demands made by leaders of the workmen who have gone on strike include higher wages, more and better food, the boycotting of all California products and the release of federal "political prisoners."

Sheriff C. R. Conn of Skagit county, who has been at scene of the strike since yesterday, and George Jessup, superintendent of the project, declared the strike had been engineered by I. W. W., who according to Jessup, constitute about 90 per cent of the 500 strikers.

Sheriff Conn today described the situation as "bad" and said that unless the situation improves he may ask Governor Louis F. Hart for the use of national guardsmen to insure order.
