

66 PRICES TAKE ON SEVERE SLUMP

Portland Drop Follows That At San Francisco; All Grades Lower

PORTLAND, Ore., Jan. 23.—Eggs took a severe slump in the local market today, following the general drop in the San Francisco. All grades were posted four cents lower in the exchange with current receipts down two cents to 45c a dozen. Extras are now quoted at 50c; extra large 50c and pullets 48c. The decline in local quotations is more in line with the east market and allows broader shipping outlet for the day's receipts. The local butter market continues steady with the supply sufficient for requirements. Extra cubes 43c; standard 41-1-2c; prime first 40c; extra 35c. Country dressed meats are holding out steady; demand is limited and receipts moderate. Choice light veal 14 to 14-1-2c; choice light hogs 14 1-1-2c. Live poultry is steady and unchanged. Receipts are fair with a moderate demand.

CHICAGO GRAIN CHICAGO, Jan. 23.—The wheat market, which varied from unchanged figures to one cent higher, May 1925 to \$1.94 and July 1925 to \$1.70, was followed by an all round rise which carried May to \$1.94. Wheat closed unsettled at 3-4c net to 1c gain. May \$1.90 3-4 to \$1.94 and July \$1.69 3-4 to \$1.70. After opening unchanged to 3-8 off, May \$1.25 1/2 to \$1.35 3-4, corn rallied a little, but then underwent a decided general setback. Corn closed nominal 2 1/2c to 3 1/4c lower. May \$1.32 1-2 to \$1.32 3-4. Starting unchanged to 1/4c up, May 2 1/2c to 2 3/4c, the oats market soon settled moderately. Provisions held steady.

COMMERCIAL BULLETIN PORTLAND, Jan. 23.—The Commercial Bulletin tomorrow will say: The wool markets of the world are in a somewhat hesitant frame of mind at the moment, the testing time being arrived. It remains to be seen whether the strong statistical position of wool or the resistance of buyers, due to the present high price will prevail. Current business on the street is of minimum proportions, although the manufacturers are in no means disinterested in the current offerings. The foreign markets are fairly strong as regards crossbred, but somewhat fluctuating on merinos. The wool sales are dragging along in a very dull manner with heavy withdrawals of "speculators' wools.
