

### EUGENE GAME FARM ADOPTED AS MODEL BY CALIFORNIANS

California will install a state game farm modeled after the Eugene farm, announces W. R. Wallace, who received word today concerning the report of George Neale, executive officer of the California Fish and Game Commission, who recently made a trip of inspection to the Eugene farm. Mr. Wallace conferred with the officer on his visit here.

The site selected for the California farm is near Sacramento, according to Mr. Wallace. Mr. Neale, he says, returned to his state so enthusiastic over the success of the local farm that he recommended that the money be appropriated this year for constructing a game farm.

"The Eugene game farm ranks first in the United States," says Mr. Wallace, "and for all we know, in the world. It is not only the largest, but the most efficient and satisfactory. A lot of local people do not realize the significance of things going on right at our own doors."

### CHANGE OF INCOME TAX LAWS IS TOLD

Explanation of the "Earned Income" provisions of the federal income tax law have been received at the local office of the internal revenue from Clyde G. Huntley, collector of revenue, with headquarters at Portland. That many tax payers are not familiar with the new law are paying more taxes than necessary, is the startling but rather welcome news being received by Lane county residents.

"The term 'earned income' is defined as consisting of wages, salaries, professional fees and other amounts received as compensation for personal services rendered," but does not include dividends received from corporations. Briefly, the law provides that if the taxpayer's net income is not more than \$5000, his entire net income shall be considered to be earned net income," the collector states.

LOS ANGELES, Jan. 30.—May 20 will mark the end of Jack Dempsey's ring career, the termination of his ring and business partnership with Jack Kearns, his manager and his second entrance into the state matrimony, according to his own announcement here today. That date is the birthday of his bride-to-be, Estelle Taylor, film actress.

The king of the heavyweights of the world has fought his last ring battle, he declared. He added that his retirement from the ring and canvas was at the behest of his betrothed, who prefers a business man to a pugilist for a husband.

The arrangement between Dempsey and Kearns has netted the pair many thousands of dollars in the past few years, as well as some valuable real estate holdings in Los Angeles. These latter, including a hotel and an apartment house, will be divided between the two, Dempsey said, and the fighter and his manager will go their separate ways.

Dempsey's decision to quit the fighting game was based on three main reasons: His belief that there was not a contender in sight able to give him a real battle; the dislike of Miss Taylor for pugilism and things pugilistic, and his fortune, which makes him independent of the fat purses offered by promoters.

### New Statistics on Forests Published

Students and others interested in forestry and forest products statistics will find valuable information in the new United States department of Agriculture yearbook, entitled "Forestry and Forest Products," declares Smith L. Taylor, ranger of the Cascade forest in the McKenzie bridge district.

"Some of the subjects covered by the statistics are forest areas, wood and timber stands and forest fires," says Mr. Taylor. "There are figures on lumber production and value, wood, wood pulp and paper. Other tables give statistical data on forest planting, national forest roads and trails, grazing, timber sales, and miscellaneous forest products."

"Comparative figures given vary only by years or decades. Tables are subdivided by states and summarized by regional groups or for the country as a whole."
