

PRODUCE MARKET EASIER IN WEEK Egg Market Still Full of Soft Spots; Bids Are Being Reduced

PORTLAND, Ore., Feb. 7.—Local produce markets as a whole were easier for the week although actual price reductions were hardly noticeable. The greater loss was in eggs with Monday's closing at 40c on extra prices against 37c at the close today with a decline of 3c in soft spots. The market still full of soft spots. The decline was not more drastic than in other egg centers, was due to the fact that local dealers still have a large stock on hand. As soon as these eggs are worked out, further declines are likely. Bids to counter declines are already being received. The butter market is generally steady with a good movement of fancy grades while undergrades, coming into competition with storage stocks was slow and weaker. Prints and butterfat prices are unchanged.
