PORTLAND, Ore., Feb. 11.—Eggs are a cent lower in all grades but pullets today with extras posted on the exchange at 35c; firsts 32c and the rest at 28c. Current receipts are down at 26c net. Receipts are normal and the market weak.

Butter continues steady and unchanged with demand and supply well balanced; extras 4 1/2c and standard 4 1/2c print prices unchanged at 4c.
