Portland, Ore., Feb. 13.—A further severe break is shown in the local egg market, with all grades posted three cents lower on Portland market.

Actual sales at the 18c level and options taken at 20 cents by foreign buyers are the latest developments in the Pacific coast egg market.

Recent sales in the valley include the Jess Sealey lot of 507 bales at Cervinus for 17c and the McPheland crop at Sherwood.
