Conductor Stops Train to Witness Own car in Ditch

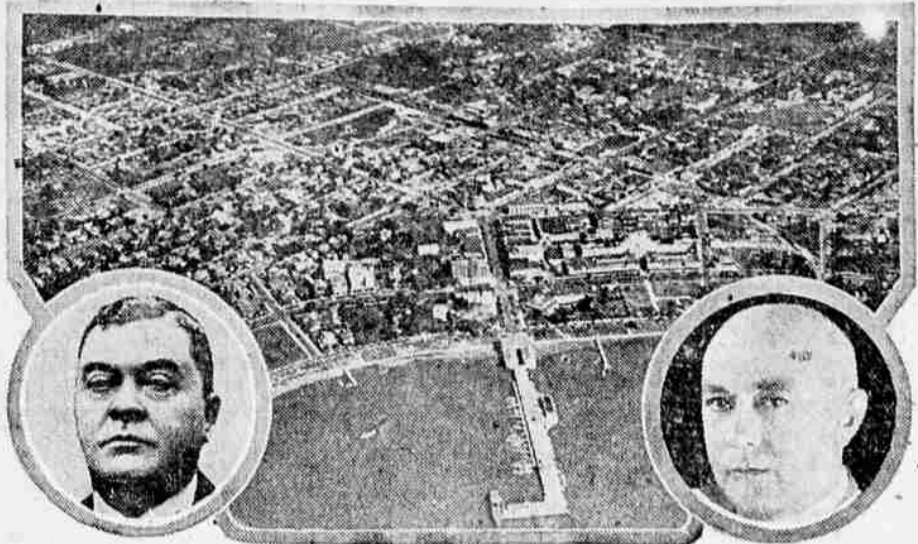
