

ADVANCE IN EGG PRICE IS HALTED

Easier Trend in Other Coast Markets Shows in Value at Portland

PORTLAND, Ore., Feb. 26.—An easier trend in other coast centers has brought about a halt in advance egg prices. Early storage on the exchange is posted steady on change stacks while current receipts are a half cent off at 28c.

With extras quoted at 33c the Portland market is considered out of line with the south and a reaction to lower levels is considered. Likely the jobbing trade. Early storage receipts were responsible for the reaction upward and while support operators are adverse to putting away many February eggs. The usual storage movement will not be made until the middle of March when quality will be better and storage safer.
