

WILLIAM A. CLARK, FORMER SENATOR, DIES IN NEW YORK

NEW YORK, March 3.—William A. Clark, 80 years old, former senator from Montana and pioneer of the copper mining industry, died in his Fifth avenue home last night of pneumonia following a cold contracted a few days ago.

Mr. Clark, who was vice-president of the United Verde Copper company, maintained a residence in Butte, Montana, his home city, in addition to one here.

An idea of his wealth is given by the fact that as far back as 1889 he received \$50,000,000 for one of his copper mines. This rise to wealth was a career which included the occupation of a farmer's helper, school teacher, law student, miner, prospector, banker and art collector.

Mr. Clark's widow was Anna Le Capelle, a Canadian physician's daughter, who became his ward on the death of her father and who was married to Mr. Clark in Marseilles in 1867. Mr. Clark was first married to Kate L. Stauffer of Connelville, Pa., in 1860. She died in 1883.

Mr. Clark's residence was one of the most pretentious structures in New York and at its completion in 1912 it was said to have cost \$5,000,000. In it Mr. Clark housed a great collection of art which had become a hobby with him.

Mr. Clark had an aversion to traveling about New York in automobiles, contending that it was too dangerous. He used instead the subway.

INAUGURATION DAY SERVICE AWAITED

deared the near approach of another inauguration day.

At the White House President Coolidge was a little busier than ordinarily, receiving distinguished visitors and keeping pace with the fevered activities of the day.

But he went about "doing the day's work" according to the motto he long ago adopted as his watchword of public service, without apparent thought of the morrow.

Mr. Dawes Calls

One of those who called on the president was Charles G. Dawes, of Chicago, the soldier-statesman, who in another 24 hours will become the nation's second in command. Following his celebrated "dipper pipe" on a trip about the city to renew old acquaintances, the vice-president-elect dropped in for an hour's chat with his chief and regaled senators whom he met in the executive offices with snips about staid parliamentary decorum he foresees for himself as presiding officer of the senate.

Delegations from a score or more of states, headed in most cases by a governor, either called to pay their respects or sent greetings to the president upon their arrival for tomorrow's ceremonies. There was a short cabinet meeting, as is customary on Tuesday and in all the crush of his duties, Mr. Coolidge found time to witness the conclusion of a marathon race in the Mall and award the prize to the winner.

Rain Is Feared

As the pre-inaugural period entered its last 24 hours, a bright sun tempered hourly the crisp air of a history March day, and the weather forecaster predicts that tomorrow would be warm enough for comfort in the outdoor stands, but sky overcast with perhaps some rain in the afternoon. If the ceremonies can be carried through on schedule, however, they should be over before the showers begin.

Under the plan of brevity and economy laid down by Mr. Coolidge, himself, the entire official program should be concluded by mid-afternoon.

in the stands of the capitol plaza to see Mr. Coolidge take the oath of office on his grandmother's bible, and send his obligation by pressing his lips to first chapter of St. John, which described the Baptism of Jesus by John the Baptist. Another 4,000 will have places in the reviewing stand at the White House but along Pennsylvania avenue there will be standing room only for the thousands who will gather there to cheer the state and national dignitaries and fighting men as they pass along in the footsteps of the great inaugural pageants of the past.

Program is Given

Except for the opening scenes, it is impossible to measure by the clock the course of tomorrow's repetition of the quadrennial drama of inauguration. If everything progresses smoothly, however, and no last minute legislative tangle upsets the expectations of officials, the day's events will move off about as follows:

10:30 a. m.—Vice-president Dawes leaves his apartment at the New Willard hotel for the White House.

11 a. m.—President Coolidge and Vice-President-Elect Dawes, accompanied by a committee of congress and cavalry escort, leave the White House for the Capitol.

11:15 a. m.—On arrival at the capitol, the president goes to his room to sign last minute legislation, and the vice-president goes to the vice-president's room.

11:30 a. m.—Senate recesses until 11:45 a. m. House adjourns sine die.

11:45 a. m.—President and vice-president-elect, house members and distinguished guests take places in senate chamber.

11:50 a. m.—Oath is administered to vice-president-elect. Retiring president Cummins of the senate makes brief address. Senate adjourns sine die.

Noon—New vice-president calls new senate to order and delivers his inaugural address. New senators are sworn in.

12:30 p. m.—Entire official party moves out to the inaugural platform on the capitol plaza, where President Coolidge takes the oath and delivers his inaugural address.

1 p. m.—President, accompanied by cavalry and court, returns to White House for buffet luncheon.

1:30 p. m.—President takes his place in reviewing standing in front of the White House to witness the passing of the inaugural parade, occupying about an hour, and bringing the official program to a close.

39 APPLICATIONS MADE FOR LOANS

SALEM, Ore., March 3.—Thirty-nine applications for loans under the \$1,500,000 farmers relief act of the recent legislature that have so far been approved total \$38,000, according to an announcement by the board late yesterday. Applications received to date number 204. The board of control which has the administration of the act believes the appropriation will easily cover all of the needs of the farmers for the reseeded of lands where the wheat crop was frozen out during the winter.

The board appoints in each county where loans are made a committee which must give its approval to an application before a loan on the application is granted. The board yesterday appointed as committee for Jefferson county J. M. King, Lewis Irving and Francis March of Madras. H. M. Setchhoff and C. S. Marsh of Metolius and George Rodman of Culver. Francis Marsh will be attorney for the committee.


