

NELSON BEERS NOT GUILTY, JURY FINDS AFTER 20 MINUTES

About 20 minutes was all that was required for a verdict of not guilty in the case of the state against Nelson Beers, Indian creek youth, whose trial on a charge of an attempted attack on a young girl has been under way in circuit court for the past two days. The case closed and a verdict was returned shortly before noon today.

A large crowd has been in attendance at the trial as it attracted considerable attention, especially among residents of the Indian creek area. After the jury announced its favorable verdict, the defendant was the center of a crowd of his friends and relatives who shook his hand and congratulated him on being cleared of the charge. Brownell and Brooks were attorneys for the defendant. The case was prosecuted by John S. Medley, district attorney, and Clyde N. Johnston. The case of the state against Ernest Eller, charged with obtaining money under false pretenses was started shortly before noon today. Brownell and Brooks are attorneys for the defendant and District Attorney John S. Medley is conducting the prosecution.

WARREN DEFEAT IS HELD FINAL

the republican leaders at the Chicago convention in 1920 by placing the name of Calvin Coolidge in nomination for vice-president and stumping the convention to him.

Chairman Cummings of the judiciary committee, who had charge of the Warren nomination in the senate was the first to present his views to the president today.

Later, Senators Watson of Indiana, Hines of New Hampshire, Reed of Pennsylvania, and Wadsworth of New York, discussed the situation at an hour's conference with the president. The senators said afterwards that Mr. Coolidge offered no comment.

MR. WARREN LEAVES
DETROIT, March 11.—(AP)—Chas. Beecher Warren, whose nomination to be attorney general was turned down by the senate yesterday, left at noon today for Washington, where he will discuss with President Coolidge and senate republican leaders what future course of action is to be taken.

Mr. Warren shortly before leaving for Washington said he did not have sufficient knowledge of the situation in Washington to enable him to make any comment on the action of the senate yesterday.

He said that President Coolidge had telephoned him and asked him to go to Washington for a conference and that until after he had been in Washington he would have nothing to say because he did not understand the situation, as he had not been there for some time nor had anything to do with the details of the political fight in the senate.

MR. McCAMANT ACTIVE
PORTLAND, Ore., March 11.—(AP)—Wallace McCamant, of Portland, who was considered at Washington today in connection with the office of attorney general, has frequently been mentioned as likely to obtain some

high federal office because of his action in placing the name of Calvin Coolidge in nomination for vice-president at the convention in 1920.

Mr. McCamant is at present practicing as an attorney at law in Portland. He was associate justice of the Oregon supreme court 1917 to 1918. He has been active in republican political circles in the state for many years. He is a former president of the National Society of Sons of the American Revolution.

SITUATION UNCERTAIN
WASHINGTON, March 11.—(AP)—The senate's rejection of the nomination of Charles B. Warren of Maine to be attorney general, at a session yesterday featured by the dramatic effects of republicans to overturn a vote on confirmation has left the question of filling that office enveloped in uncertainty.

With the White House declining to comment on the matter, there was no indication today what course President Coolidge will pursue.

Only by the president's re-nomination of the nominee can it come again before the senate, whose action yesterday, after voting 40 to 49 on confirmation in finally tabling it to 39 a motion to reconsider as the upshot of hurried republican strategy to overturn the tie, is final and irrevocable.

Two Courses Open.
As an alternate to resuming the Warren nomination or sending a new name to the senate, the president may either leave Solicitor General Beck in charge of the justice department until the next session of congress, or make a recess appointment for that period.

Coming with almost startling suddenness late in the day, the vote on confirmation apparently caught the administration off guard. While democratic opponents of the nomination sought to clinch their victory by demanding that the roll call be closed and administration leaders strove to delay it, a tactical dash by Vice-President Dawes from his hotel to the capitol in an effort to arrive in time to break the tie was awaited as the impending climax.

Senator Reed Switches.
He was too late for that, the roll call having been announced, but in the meantime republican leaders had resorted to further strategy when Senator Reed of Pennsylvania switched his vote to the opposition column, making the result, technically 39 to 41, so that he might move reconsideration of the question.

On an immediate counter motion of opponents of confirmation to lay the Reed motion on the table, the senate had concluded another tie vote, 40 to 40, just as the vice-president, who could have cast the deciding ballot, entered the chamber. When at this juncture, Senator Overman of North Carolina, the only democrat who had voted for confirmation, switched his vote, the motion to reconsider was tabled and the right was ended.

Nine Republicans Oppose.
Not counting the preliminary switch in Senator Reed's vote, nine republicans joined all of the democrats present, except Senator Overman and the

one farmer-labor senator, Shipstead, in voting against confirmation.

A number of administration senators visited the White House today to discuss the situation growing out of the rejection of Mr. Warren's nomination, but none would undertake to interpret the views or purposes of Mr. Coolidge.

Senator Cummings of Iowa, chairman of the judiciary committee, which favorably reported the nomination, said however, that he could not see where another vote would change the situation, adding that most of the senators who were absent yesterday were paired.
