

ZONEING LAWS FOR EUGENE ARE URGED

That some definite action toward the appointment of a city zoning commission will be taken in Eugene in the near future, is the opinion expressed today by Mayor E. B. Parks. This plan which has aroused considerable interest recently was the subject of a recent conference between Miss Mozelle Blair, of the extension division of the University of Oregon, and Mayor Parks.

"Arrangements will probably be made for a meeting in the near future to discuss the zoning plan," Mayor Parks said. "With representatives present from various local organizations that take an interest in civic problems it is hoped that some definite suggestions will be received that will lead to action by the city council for the appointment of a permanent commission and also the framing of some zoning ordinances."

Recently there have been several matters in the way of building of business places in residence districts that have caused property owners to look to the city council for some relief from further invasion of streets that should be restricted to residence purposes," the mayor states.
