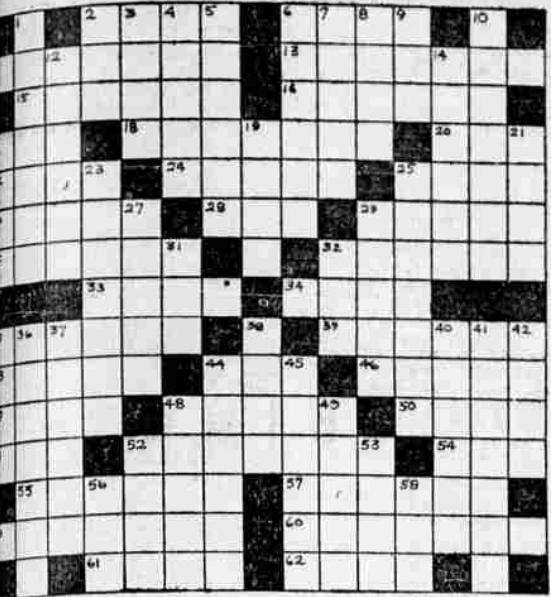

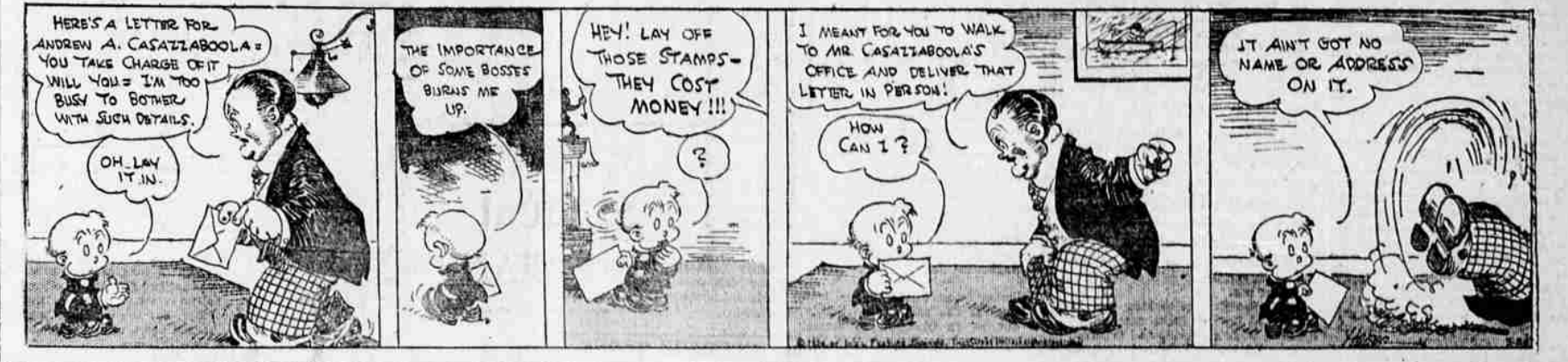

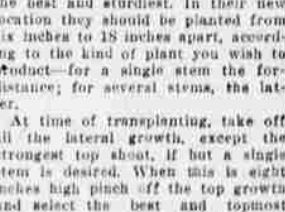
LODGE MAY ENTER
