X-Ray Filter is Thought Found

PARIS, April 2.—A filter, which it is claimed will make x-ray harmless and cure radio-dermatitis, the disease which has afflicted or killed many scientists using the rays, was described to the Academy of Sciences last night by Daniel Berthelot. The filter is the invention of two French scientists, J. Daler and P. Moutain. The inventors had the idea of using the antagonism of the infrared rays toward the radiation of shorter wave lengths. Living tissues exposed to x-rays and then exposed to the action of the infrared rays, showed no signs of radio-dermatitis nor any essential modification. The inventors claim to have cured persons suffering from radio-dermatitis after three or four applications to their system.

Labor is Declared To be Opposed to System of Soviet

BOSTON, April 2.—The American Federation of Labor "defies" the Soviet system of government and is opposed to recognition of the Russian communist regime. Matthew Well, vice-president of the organization declared at a stormy meeting in a public forum here Sunday. Radical supporters in the audience greeted his denunciation of the Russian government with cries of "lar!" but the director of the forum restored order. Mr. Well declared that the American Federation of Labor stood for the voluntary cooperative system of bringing about just aims of labor and would not tolerate what he called the compulsory cooperative system of socialists, communists and syndicalists. He asserted that the communist in Russia were in the Russian people and did not represent the Russian people as a nation.

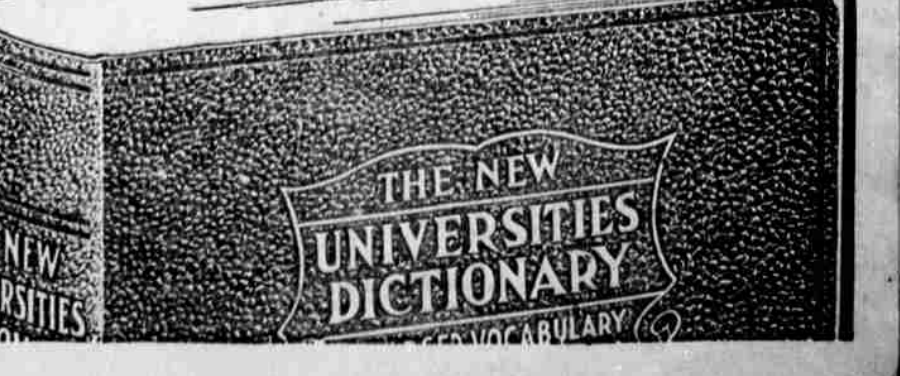
