The City of Eugene, Lane County, Oregon

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to the terms of Section 30, Chapter 5 of the Charter of the City of Eugene, Oregon, and Ordinance Number 4636 passed by the Common Council of the City of Eugene on the ninth day of February, 1925, and approved by the Mayor on the ninth day of February, 1925, a Special Municipal Election will be held in said City on Wednesday, April 15th, 1925, from the hour of eight o'clock in the forenoon to the hour of eight o'clock in the afternoon, and at said Election, the following proposed Charter Amendments will be submitted to the Electors of said City, referred by the Common Council for their approval or rejection, to-wit:

1. An Act to amend the Charter of the City of Eugene, Oregon, by adding a new chapter thereto authorizing and empowering the Common Council of the City to issue and sell negotiable bonds of the City to the amount of Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the purpose of constructing and reconstructing certain sections of the drainage and sewer system of the City, and to repeal the Act entitled "An Act to amend the Charter of the City of Eugene, Oregon, by adding a new chapter thereto authorizing and empowering the Common Council of the City to issue and sell negotiable bonds of the City to the amount of Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the purpose of constructing and reconstructing certain sections of the drainage and sewer system of the City, and to repeal section 37, of Chapter 7, of the Charter of the City limiting the indebtedness to be created or contracted by the City to Three Thousand (\$3,000) Dollars, enacted by the electors of said city at an election held July 2nd, 1924."
