

SCHOOL DISTRICTS OF WESTERN LANE FURNISH INTEREST

Some very interesting notations on the school districts of western Lane are contained in a brief diary kept by Arnold Collier, assistant county superintendent of schools, who last week visited many of the school areas, this being the first time that Mr. Collier has visited this district of the county.

Especially interesting is the account of the pupils at the Mercer school who have never seen a railroad train or street car, but are thoroughly familiar with airplanes as they have seen many of these during the summer forest patrol flying from the Eugene base.

The following are the notes taken by the assistant superintendent on his trip of a week:

Left car at Mapleton. Went on mail boat "Althea" with Wallace S. Robinson who delivers mail by boat to people between Mapleton and Florence, to Cushman District 101.

D. William Hatch is principal and teaches 4th to 8th grades. Beatrice Watkins teaches lower grades.

In two picture frames in Hatches room were copies of the New York Herald, for Saturday, April 15, 1925, telling of Lincoln's death.

Here they are preparing a program to celebrate National Forest week.

A new four-room school building is to be built during the summer. Excavating now for it.

District No. 115. Two-room school. William Haley, upper grades. Rosalie Roth, lower grades. More than 40 children attend the school. School boats instead of buses carry pupils to school. All come in boats.

Florence is visited.

Florence, District No. 97. Principal of Union high school, No. 10, Robert A. Brady. Teacher in Union high school, Dorothy Brady. Principal of grades, Mrs. E. H. Morrison.

Mrs. Seifert had exhibits of rope weaving and knots in her room done by her pupils. Many mariner's knots were made—the pupils getting the information from old seamen.

High school student body enjoyed a beach party Tuesday night after school.

Glenn, District No. 127. Old school abandoned. School is in a two-story building, formerly a rooming house. Gertrude Bradley is teacher and has 10 pupils.

Walked from Glenn to Porter's landing (three miles) on Clear lake. Met there by Albert Christensen, a farmer and boat maker. He made the Althea which is a mail boat between Mapleton and Florence and used her on the harbor for fishing boats.

Mrs. Seifert took me across the lake to District No. 109 to the Whoochink school, taught by Edda Maaranen. She has three pupils. "What they lacked in numbers they made up in quality," Christensen took me to the new outlet of Clear lake and I walked over to Westlake, District No. 170.

School is being taught by Mrs. Vena McLean of Springfield, who has had 100 per cent attendance for three months and is now on fourth month. Recitation still over mill burning.

At Westlake Ernest Christensen took me in his boat to Talloos.

District No. 173. Mr. J. Lloyd Northrup teaches here. School is up on a hill overlooking the beautiful lake. Mr. Northrup has seven children of his own in school. He has been required for next year.

Walked to Canby.

Walked to Canby, District No. 90. New school house there first term in it. Miss Geneva Denning is teacher.

Stayed all night at the Scott home. Mrs. Scott is clerk of district. Besides two sons, two boys are kept who work for their room and board, so as to have the advantages of the good school. They are Lloyd Springs in the eighth grade and Sam Springs in the seventh grade.

Walked to District No. 171 on Upper Maple creek. School taught by Hae A. Young. Five pupils.

Walked back to District No. 157. Idylwyld school, taught by Edith Webster. New school house (first term for it). Modern in every way. Beautiful location on a hillside.

Went back to Florence that night and went to Mercer lake school District No. 140. Thursday morning. Trip made in Ford. Roads very bad. The schoolhouse and hickory brush had been cut down to make a roadway through swamp. Mrs. Mary L. Duwell teaches at Mercer lake. School is up on a hill overlooking the ocean a

couple of miles away. Fourteen pupils—three had never lived where they could attend school until this year and are making rapid progress in school work. These children had never seen a railroad engine, street car nor had ever been to Florence. "We've seen airplanes though, and we keep track of the ships that go by," said the oldest one of the three. Mrs. Duwell is giving the pupils of the district many advantages that lots of schools do not have even though the school is so isolated.

Heceta is visited.

Walked to Heceta Head where the famous light house is.

W. H. Coffin is teacher. Has seven pupils. The school house is only 100 yards from the ocean. The beach is the play ground. The light house stands up on the hill above the school. Had luncheon with Mr. and Mrs. Frank De Roy, the head keeper of the light house. Wonderful people. Baked bread and fed to birds all winter.

Mrs. De Roy said according to legend Heceta was the goddess of the infernal regions and someone had named the show places with names pertaining to the infernal region.

There is the Devil's Elbow, Devil's Churn, Devil's Backbone, Devil's Pumphouse, all magnificent show places of interest to the traveler.

"Heceta is a place where one could spend a week in enjoying the formation and interesting places." To know one's own county they must see Heceta Head.
