MEDFORD, Ore., April 17.—Medford sportsmen are still discussing the removal of Dorris from the team at the unexpected turn of events at the night's annual Fish and Game Production Contest. The Medford Fish and Game Production Contest Association, which is a branch of the Multnomah association, called upon the members of the team to go on record concerning any proposed change in the personnel of the team. The officials, with particular reference to the retention of Captain Dorris, state game warden, Harold Clifford, chairman, R. W. Stone and Judge J. W. Maloney, who are present at the contest, but who are not interested in the game, and was not interested in the retention of any particular individual. A majority of local sportsmen appear to be convinced that this means Dorris is slated for dismissal in the future.

STEAMERS COLLIDE OFF POINT ADAMS

ASTORIA, April 17.—The Japanese steamer Yoshida Maru Number 1 and the steamer Charles R. McCormick collided head on early this morning in the Columbia river off the Point Adams life saving station. Both vessels were damaged. One fireman on the Japanese was injured. The Charles R. McCormick, which proceeded on up stream to the Astoria anchorage was reported as taking water in a forward hold. The Yoshida Maru Number 1 absorbed the shock in the destruction of its forepeak tank and was not taking water in any of its freight holds. The Japanese freighter was en route from Portland with a full cargo of lumber for Shanghai. The Charles R. McCormick was en route upstream to Portland with general freight from Atlantic coast ports. Confused signals were blamed for the smash.

Mrs. Cunningham Too Weak to go On Witness Stand

CROWN POINT, Ind., April 17.—Mrs. Anna Cunningham, 49 year old Gary, Ind., widow, who has confessed she poisoned three of her children and tried to end her own life so they would join her husband, "in heaven," still was too weak today for a preliminary hearing on the charge that she murdered her son Walter. County Prosecutor August A. Bremer pointed out today that the report of Purdue university chemists, received last night, corroborated Mrs. Cunningham's confession. The chemists found a large amount of arsenic in the vital organs of Walter Cunningham, while admitting that she poisoned Walter, Isabel and Charles Cunningham, denied that she had given Harry any poison. She also told of giving poison to David Jr., who is in a hospital.

The new cabinet will command about the same majority in the chamber of deputies as the outgoing administration, but it cannot count on socialist support, for when the socialist party congress endorsed M. Herriot during his premiership it reserved the right to withdraw its support whenever this appears necessary. M. Briand's handling of the railroad strike when premier in 1910 incurred him with the bitter enmity of the socialists. In the senate the ministry will meet with considerable opposition owing principally to the appointment of M. Caillaux. Former Premier Poincare on learning of Caillaux' appointment is reported to have exclaimed: "Caillaux is a challenge to the senate."

Salt Lake Firemen Resign When Chief Is Again Retained

SALT LAKE CITY, Utah, April 17.—Members of the city commission will meet with Mayor C. C. Neeson here today to consider the blanket resignation of 91 Salt Lake firemen, effective April 21, which was tendered yesterday when the commission, after a two weeks hearing failed to oust Fire Chief William H. Bywater, despite a petition signed by 100 fire fighters asking his removal. The firemen in their petition accused their chief of arbitrary conduct. If the resignation is accepted Salt Lake's regular fire fighting force after next Tuesday will consist of seven officials and less than a half dozen firemen, augmented by about 30 recruits, who have been trained intensively for the last three weeks in anticipation of the resignation.
