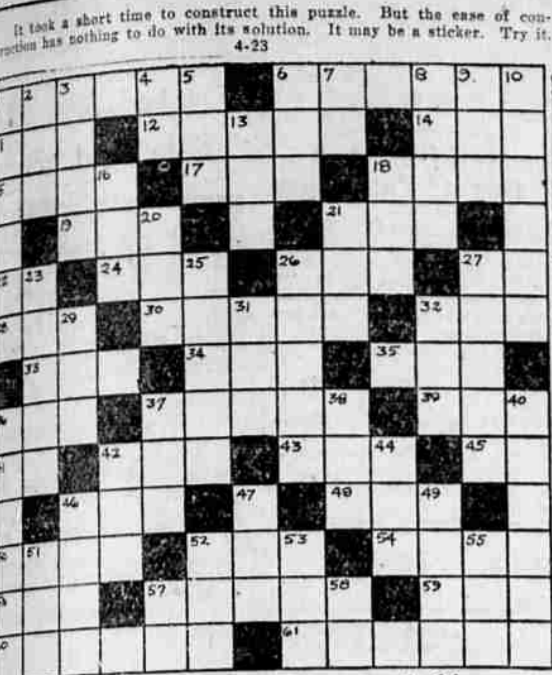

Radio Programs

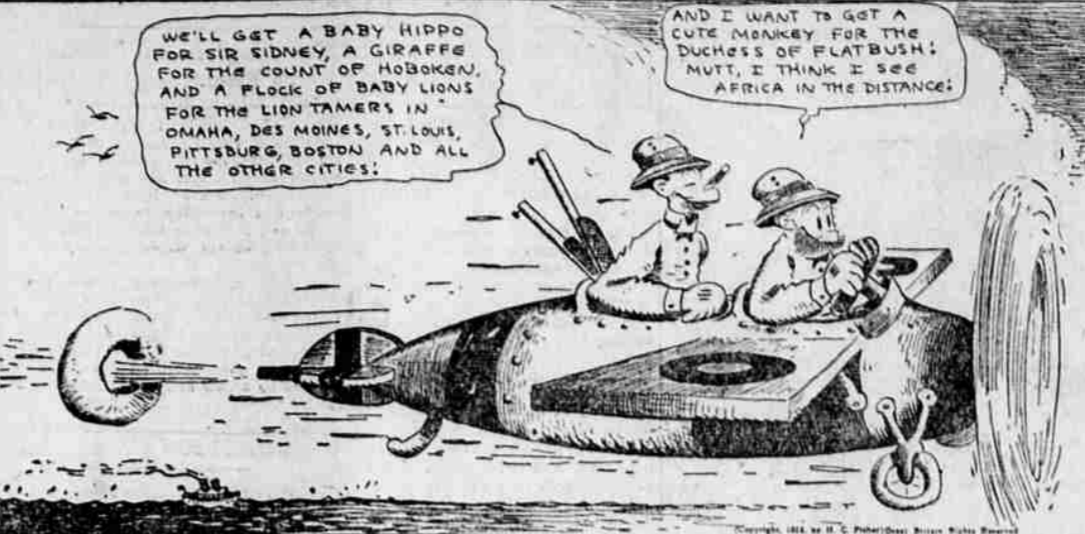

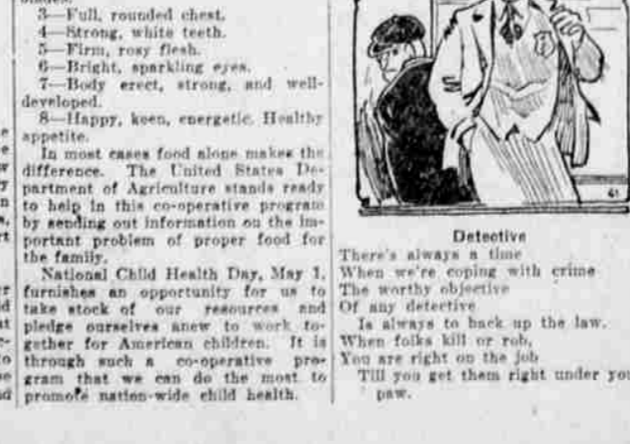
- Kitchen Cabinet: You can make a kitchen cabinet by using a kitchen table and grouping about it shelves, with or without doors.
