WORK WILL START AT ONCE ON NEW APARTMENT HOUSE

Erection of a four-room apartment house in the north side of Eighth avenue west between Lincoln and Lawrence streets is planned by Darwin E. Yoran, postmaster, and the work of moving his present home farther north on the lot will be started this week, the owner announced today.

The plans for the new apartment building which will be erected on the Eighth avenue frontage of the property which has a dimension of 67 feet to the alley in the rear of 207 feet, include the installation of a private roadway along the east boundary of the property to a row of six garages to be erected on the alley. The present Yoran home will be remodeled for two apartments and plans are for the erection of another two-room apartment house north of the present home.

All apartments will be of four rooms each, according to the plans under way by John Huzicki, local architect.

There is a considerable length to the Yoran property from Eighth avenue north as the turn to the south of Eighth avenue makes this an unusually long block.

HEAT RECORD IS SET FOR EUGENE

With a temperature of 85 degrees at 1 o'clock this afternoon the heat record for the present year so far was registered at the hygrothermograph at the office of the Cascade national forest service. Later this afternoon this was a slight improvement in the heat situation and a drop of a few degrees was noted at the forest office instruments. The relative humidity was down to 40 which is considered rather dangerous for the spread of fires if started, according to Nelson F. Macduff, Cascade forest supervisor.

FEDERAL ACTION IS ORDERED FOR LANE

On the ground that it was improperly transferred to the federal court at Portland, the case of the National Thrift association of this city against Darwin E. Yoran, postmaster of Eugene, has been remanded back to the Lane county circuit court, according to word received here today. The case was brought by the association when the postmaster under department orders declined to deliver mail to the organization here and marked it "fraudulent" for return to the senders.

H. E. Slattery is attorney for the association. Mr. Yoran is represented by the federal district attorney's office at Portland. The case will probably be tried here at the June term of court. The action of the postal department on the association is based on certain provisions against lotteries which are said to pertain to the plans of the thrift association.

Lorane Road Plan Will be Taken up

Decision as to the route of the Lorane highway will be made by the county court tomorrow. One petition signed by 68 residents asks that the survey follow the old route over the hill. Another petition signed by about 50 residents of the same district requests that the new proposed survey beyond the hill be followed. Clinton Hurd, county commissioner, planned to go to the Lorane district this afternoon to inspect both routes before making a decision in the matter.
