

FOUR FRATERNITIES
CONSTRUCT HOMES
\$145,000 IN VALUE

Four new houses, now being constructed by University of Oregon living organizations, represent a total investment of \$145,000. Three of the houses are being built for sororities, and one for a fraternity. The houses are being built on new lots, and the organizations will have other housing organizations will be during the fall term, according to the program to date.

The new houses now under construction are: Alpha Tau Omega, Kappa Gamma, Delta Delta Delta, and Gamma Phi Beta. The Alpha Tau Omega fraternity will build a house at 574 13th avenue east. The present home at 751 12th street is to be used as a nurse's home. Alpha Omicron Pi sorority, at present located at 121 Paterano street, will move into the present Kappa Gamma house at 754 east 13th street. The new Alpha Tau Omega house is under construction and is expected to be ready for occupancy in the fall term. The fraternity will build a house at 18th avenue and 10th street, situated at 18th avenue and 10th street is of an Italian-Spanish style. It will house 35 women, being considerably larger than the present home. Delta Delta Delta will move into their new home at the beginning of the fall term also. They are at present occupying a house at 217 13th avenue east, and will move to 20th street east and University street. The new building will contain 10 rooms and will be of a French-chateau style. It will house 32 women. The Gamma Phi Beta sorority's new building will be completed next October. It will be of English Colonial style, and especially large, being designed to house 35 women. The site is on the Mill race near Hilliard street. The present home is at 1415 University street.

New houses built last year were: Sigma Nu, Beta Theta Pi, Phi Gamma Delta, Kappa Alpha Theta, and Alpha Phi. Besides these, Lambda Chi Alpha, a fraternity, newly founded in the campus this year, took up occupancy of their present home at 10th avenue east and Kincaid streets.

Humidity Low Is
Warning Sent Out

The weather bureau service in Portland is already sending out warnings of relative low humidity, reports R. S. Shelley, supervisor of the Siuslaw national forest. The forecast for today and the rest of this week is that the relative humidity will be low enough to be dangerous, and all forty men have been notified to exercise extra caution, says Mr. Shelley. It is during low humidity that forest fires are most in danger of fires, and a two or three day period will bring a dangerous condition. It is stated.
