

FURNITURE FOR NEW SCHOOLS IS BOUGHT

Complete furnishings for the new Roosevelt and Woodrow Wilson junior high schools were purchased last night by the district school board, at a special session. Linoleum, desks, seats, and chairs were purchased.

The successful bidders were as follows:

Linoleum, 2230 yards at \$2.45, plus \$316.50 for brass nosings, Wetherbee-Powers company, Eugene, at \$5,755.40.

Pupils' desks, 900, Heywood-Wakefield company, Portland, \$4,065.75. Portable chairs, for auditorium, 1200, Heywood-Wakefield company, Portland, \$4,122.

Teachers' chairs, 30, Northwest Furniture company, Portland, \$172.50.

Teachers' desks, 25, Koke-Tiffany, Eugene, \$622.50.

The board also adopted a resolution stating that in the future single women would be given preference when hiring teachers for Eugene schools.

The ruling does not affect teachers now under contract, it is stated. Teachers hired from now on, however, automatically terminate their contracts when they marry.
