We have received not less than two serious complaints and have received copies of your newspaper ad wherein you were advertising our brooms at a very much lower price than they should be sold for.

In shipping you brooms as we did, we felt confident that you would adhere to a legitimate profit on the retail selling price. In your case of course, we allowed you the 10% trade discount, and you probably felt that under the circumstances you could sell these brooms at a lower price. We wish to advise however, that we are selling a good many accounts in your city, and these other accounts are not buying in quantities to warrant our allowing them the trade discount, and for this reason you can see the injustice to the other merchants who are not getting this discount, and are compelled to sell our brooms at a slightly higher price.

You still have a balance with us on order of March 28th, to go forward and under the circumstances we are going to ask that we be allowed to place your own private labels on these brooms, and call them different names, which will then enable you to sell them at whatever price you wish, inasmuch as if brooms go forward under our regular labels, we must insist that you get the regular selling price.
